WHEREAS, Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 was created pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Health and Safety Code to support fire and emergency services within the district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 as a taxing District, after hearing and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, determined that the Taxing District should impose a sales tax, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the district; and

WHEREAS, Texas Health and Safety code Chapter 775 authorizes Special Taxing Units the authority to submit a proposition to county voters to fix and impose a sales and use tax of 2 per cent to provide funds associated with the maintenance and operations of an emergency services district; and

WHEREAS, the long term financial support of the emergency services district is critical for the health and safety of county citizens, tourists, and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Board of Commissioners of Limestone Emergency Services District #2 is to support the provisions of fire protection and first response to the Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 citizens; and WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 supports the use of tax dollars designated for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 deems it to be in the best interest of the district and its constituents to submit such a proposition to the district voters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of West Lake Limestone Emergency Services District #2 as follows:

- Findings. All of the recitals contained in the preambles of this Resolution are adopted and incorporated herein as the official findings and determination of the board.
- 2) <u>Call of Election</u>. An election shall be held on Saturday, May 1, 2021, which date is one of the uniform election dates specified in and permitted by the Texas Elections Code. The Election shall be held within and throughout the boundaries and service area of Limestone County Emergency Services District #2. All resident, qualified voters within such boundaries and service area shall be entitled to vote. The commissioners find that holding the election on a uniform election date is in the public interest.
- Proposition. The proposition on the ballot shall be "The adoption of a local sales and use tax in Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 at the rate of two percent."
- 4) <u>Election</u>. The election shall be held in compliance with the Elections Code, and shall be administered by the Limestone County Elections Administrator. Farly voting dates, polling locations and elections workers shall be arranged by the elections administrator according to the standard practices for Limestone County elections. This board shall execute whatever contracts and further resolutions might be required to conduct this election.
- 5) <u>Statement of Intent</u>. In calling this election, the Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 expresses its intent that the taxes generated be used solely for the purpose of providing funds for costs associated with financing, design, acquisition, construction, equipping, operating, maintaining, remodeling, repairing, re-equipping and improvements of Limestone County Emergency Services District #2 and its service providers.
