The purpose of "Dangerous Religious Ideas" is to examine four issues in the Abrahamic faith traditions. First, it will challenge assumptions about which religious ideas are dangerous, analyze the way in which religion causes harm and destruction, and argues that all three Abrahamic religions developed methods for self-critique, and finally the course encourages examination of interreligious ideas and engagement.

This course is based on a book by the same name, Dangerous Religious Ideas, authored by Rabbi Dr. Rachel Mikva, Professor of Jewish Studies at the Chicago Theological Seminary (CTS). While enrolled at CTS's MA Religious Studies program, Jerra took the course Dangerous Religious Ideas with Rabbi Mikva.

Jerra encourages those who participate in the study to purchase the book by Rabbi Mikva though that will be optional. It is suggested to read ahead if you choose to purchase the book.


