Scholarships

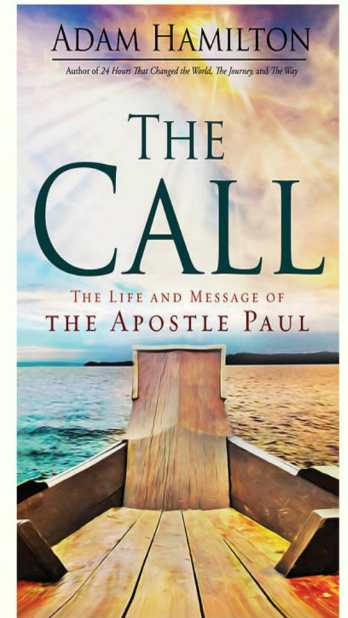

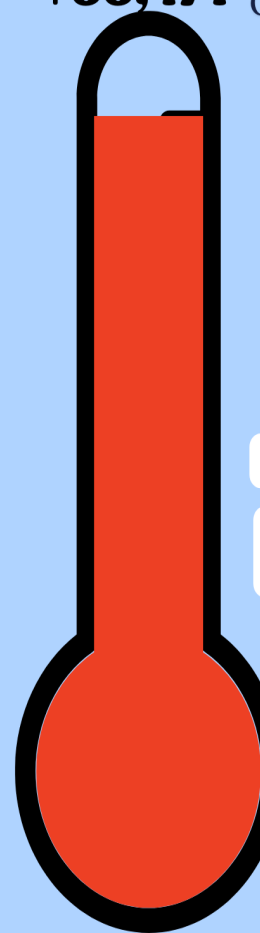

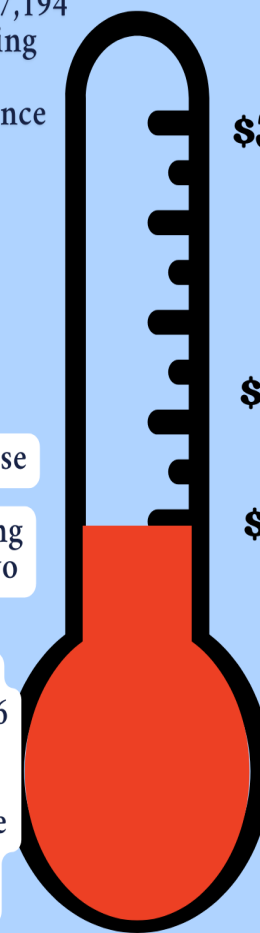
