Job Description: Director of Youth Ministries

Classification: 15 hours/part-time professional

Responsible to: Edinboro United Methodist Staff Parish Relations Committee,

through the Lead Pastor.

Purpose: To serve the Edinboro United Methodist Church and Edinboro community by working with the lead pastor and church staff to develop Christian disciples, engage youth and their families, and support inter-generational ministries.

Qualifications: The Director of Youth Ministries shall:

- Experience working with youth in ministry or related field.
- Practice a lifestyle that reflects and encourages a close, personal relationship with Jesus Christ, consistent with United Methodist discipline and theology.
- Possess strong personal convictions, yet demonstrate a caring, empathetic demeanor that respects diversity in church visitors, congregants, and community members.
- Demonstrate effective leadership by planning and organizing assigned duties and working effectively without immediate supervision.
- Be physically capable of carrying out required activities.
- Possess or develop excellent skills in relationship development, teaching and training, empathy and support, managing volunteers, and visioning/goal-setting, and commitment to team ministry.

Responsibilities: The responsibilities of the position of Director of Youth Ministries shall include, but not be limited to the following:

A. Under the guidance of the Lead Pastor:

- 1. Oversee the Youth Ministries of the Edinboro United Methodist Church and direct the mission and vision.
- 2. Encourage and nurture the youth and their families in living the Christian faith and supporting the local church.
- 3. Explore and implement ways to keep youth and families involved in their faith and life of the local church and community.
- 4. Recruit and train volunteers to assist and support in the ministry.
- 5. Be a mentor, companion, resource and positive role model for the youth and their families.
- 6. Collaborate with the Children's Sunday School to develop joint programs when appropriate.

- 7. Participate in training relevant to the position as directed by Pastor and/or SPRC.
- 8. Communicate effectively using all available resources (email, social media, text messages, newsletter, phone, apps such as "Remind", etc.).
- 9. Regularly update church calendar (through church office) with youth related activities.
- 10. Develop and manage budgets for Youth Program.
- 11. Attends and sends reports to the Intentional Faith Formation Committee of the Edinboro United Methodist Church.
- 12. Ensure that Safe Sanctuary policies and practices are observed in all ministry activities and adhere to confidential policies.

B. Other duties as may be assigned.

Compensation: as established by the SPRC.

- Work hours, salary, benefits (including Paid Time Off), as determined by SPRC and church policy.
- Job performance will be reviewed after a ninety (90) day period for a newly hired Youth Director. A review committee selected by the SPRC will hold annual performance reviews thereafter.
- Coordinate vacation or times of personal renewal with Lead Pastor.
