- Possess strong personal convictions, yet demonstrate a caring, empathetic demeanor that respects diversity in church visitors, congregants, and community members.
- Demonstrate strong organization, administration, and communication skills, and a high energy level.
- Demonstrate the ability to work effectively without immediate supervision.
- Possess or develop excellent skills in relationship development, teaching and training, empathy and support, managing volunteers, and visioning/goal-setting.
- Maintain Act 33 and Act 34 clearances, as well as an FBI Clearance.

Responsibilities: The responsibilities of the position of Director of Youth and Family Ministries shall include, but not be limited to the following:

A. Under the guidance of the Lead Pastor:

- 1. Create a sustainable children and youth ministry that is inviting to those in the community as well as in our congregation.
 - a. Conduct weekly youth meetings.
 - b. Conduct monthly children's activities.
 - c. Conduct monthly youth activities outside of the weekly youth meetings.
- 2. Be an advocate for children, youth, and families, educating the congregation and community on the hopes and needs of these populations.
- 3. Resource and oversee the Age Level Coordinators for the children and youth Sunday School program, working in conjunction with the Intentional Faith Formation (IFF) Committee.
- 4. Serve on appropriate committees as appointed or suggested by the pastor.
- 5. Identify and access resources that are designed to address the needs of children and youth.
- 6. Recruit and train volunteers to assist and support in Children and youth programs and activities.
- 7. Serve as a liaison with community organizations and groups.
- 8. Participate in training relevant to the position as directed by Pastor and/or SPRC.
- 9. Communicate appropriately using all available resources (email, social media, text messages, newsletter, phone, apps such as "Remind", etc.).
- 10. Ensure that Safe Sanctuary policies and practices are observed in all ministry activities.
