I am the parent/guardian of _____ and I certify that I am familiar with the activities engaged in by the participants of the Children’s Athletic Training School (CATS) program, and I certify that my child has no conditions that prohibit or limit participation in any CATS program. I agree that my child assumes ordinary risk of injury, or risk of injury caused by a condition or practice common to a particular activity or sport, while on the premises where CATS classes are held. I further agree not to hold CATS or any of its affiliates or subsidiaries, or any of its instructors, supervisors, or any employees liable for any injury sustained by myself or my child while on the premise where CATS classes are held. I will see that my child will be supervised prior to and after his/her CATS program. I understand that program fees are due in full by May 1, 2024. CATS reserves the right to expel any student whose behavior is considered disruptive and/or dangerous to him/her or others. Expelled students are not eligible for a refund.

REFUND POLICY: Tuition in the summer camp is **NON-REFUNDABLE**. A \$300.00 deposit is required. The full balance is due by May 1st, 2024. A \$50.00 fee is charged for returned checks.

Make Ups: There are **NO MAKE UP DAYS** even under the most extenuating circumstances. Please do not ask. If you notify the office in advance we can try to reschedule a day.

If in case of accident or injury to my child and the emergency contact designated cannot be reached, I authorize CATS through its employees, to obtain medical attention for my child.

I understand that CATS retains the rights to any photographs taken at CATS to be used for social media, publicity or advertising.

By signing below, I certify that I understand and accept all enrollment conditions.

Lunch: Pack a **NUT FREE** lunch or **NAME LABELED** lunch money for the pizza drop box (\$3 for pizza lunch). CATS will provide a snack each day. We also have a microwave in our lunchroom if you wish to send something that needs to be heated. **Please be advised that we do not allow any type of NUTS in the facility. Although a favorite, peanut butter and jelly is not allowed for lunch. Please carefully check ALL food that you send! Don’t forget to check snacks as well! This ensures the safety of all our students and we appreciate your help. Even if made in a facility that may contain traces of nuts, we cannot permit it in the facility. If you send a sun butter as a peanut butter substitute, please write it on the sandwich.**

Welcome Letter Summer 2024

Dear CATS SUMMER Parents,

Welcome to the CATS Summer Program! We are excited to be back for another fun filled summer with your children. Although our program is designed to be fun for the children, our approach and philosophies are proven to provide true learning outcomes. Children who attend our program generally experience:

- Improved self-esteem, self-respect, and self-confidence.
- Enhanced athletic ability as well as intellectual skill development.
- Greater degree of responsibility and leadership.
- New friendships and development of social skills.
- Greater personal independence.

CATS has been focusing on these outcomes for 40 years! The staff is committed to providing each child with the best possible experience. Your child will participate in sports activities focusing on skill development and low-level competition. Aside from all of the sports your children will be playing, our program also includes backyard Water Activities with a water slide and kiddie pool, Music & Movement, Virtual Games & Activities, Arts & Crafts, Yoga, Karate, and more. As with most activities in which your children participate, having your support in a few key areas can really help both CATS and your child succeed. Your assistance is needed to ensure a successful program and positive experience for all children.

Daily Preparation - Please send your children with a **NAME-LABELED** backpack or bag along with a towel and a change of clothes. It would be greatly appreciated if you could **NAME-LABEL** everything to help avoid losing items. This includes bags, towels, water bottles & lunch boxes. Basically, ANYTHING you send...LABEL! Have your child arrive to CATS in their bathing suit so we do not have to change them twice each day. Diapers and wipes should also be sent along with your child for those not yet potty trained. **SWIM DIAPERS ARE NOT NECESSARY**. Please also make sure that you have completed and returned the Diaper Changing/Bathroom help Authorization Form & the Studio Consent form. Children should also be wearing sneakers upon arrival. **NO WATER SHOES, FLIP FLOPS OR SANDALS**. The backyard is turfed. Sunscreen should be applied before camp and at your discretion. The backyard area is mostly shaded. **NUT FREE** snacks will be provided for ALL campers. You do not need to send a snack. If you do send snack, it must be **NUT FREE!**

LUNCH PROGRAM (between 12 & 12:30) - Please be advised that **we DO NOT allow any type of NUTS in the CATS facility**. Pack a **NUT FREE** lunch or send in name-labeled lunch money for pizza lunch (\$3 daily). You may put money on file for pizza, but you must send it in labeled with child's name. You can let us know each morning at drop off if your child is having pizza or if they have their own lunch. Although a favorite, peanut butter and jelly is not allowed for lunch. Please carefully check any food that you send in! Do not forget to check snacks as well! This ensures the safety of all our students, and we appreciate your help. If you send a nut free type of "peanut butter" please label it! Send a water bottle labeled with the child's name. We also have a microwave and toaster oven in our lunchroom if you wish to send something that needs to be heated.

Drop Off & Pick up Information

Please be considerate of our neighborhood residents and avoid blocking driveways around CATS – The driveways are private. Please also avoid double-parking. We will do our best to assist during drop off and pick up times. Double-parking is only permitted when orange cones appear in front of the building. Otherwise, double-parking is prohibited. We offer staggered drop off times to break up congestion. You must select a drop-off time of either 9am or 9:15am. Those selecting the 9:15 option may pick up 15 minutes after your scheduled pickup time. Please make sure to select on the registration form which time suits your schedule. We will be using two entrances to avoid long lines. Door #1 is the main entrance door. Door #2 is to the right when facing the CATS building.

DOOR #2 will be strictly designated for families with 2 year olds only. This means you should drop off your 2 year old and their siblings at door #2. This is to help the little ones with separation anxiety. Dismissals will be done at Door #1 only. Your child will be ready for pick up at the time you provided. If you need to adjust your time, make sure to do so at drop off. If something changes, you may call or email to let us know.

REMINDER – YOUR CHILD MUST STAY HOME IF THEY HAVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

- Temperature 100.4 or higher.
- A new or worsening cough or a cough gets worse.
- Difficulty or trouble breathing.
- Loss of taste or smell.
- Sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, chills, muscle pain, excessive fatigue, new or severe headache, nasal congestion, or runny nose.

Emergency Numbers – We would like to have at least two emergency numbers on file. However, many of you have provided just one. If you fall into this category, please contact me with an additional number to add to your child's profile.

Additional Studio Space - We will be using the additional studio space again at Hagen-Kavanagh School of Dance. This will allow for more CATS activities and fun! The location is adjacent to CATS at 182 Maple Ave. You are receiving this communication as a parent or guardian of a child who will be taking advantage of the additional space. This means your child will likely rotate, one time, to and from this location between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm. The space is located just 100' from our front door. While the walk is quick and safe, it is imperative we have your approval in order to bring your child to the studio. This will not change the drop off or pick up locations. I would appreciate it if each family would state their approval on the authorization forms.

Social Media – We will be posting daily/weekly content of our CATS campers. Pictures and videos will be posted on our Instagram and Facebook pages. Instagram @catskidsofrvc & Facebook Cats Rvc. We love allowing our CATS families to get a glimpse into their child's day. If you do not wish for your child to be posted on our social media platforms please let us know.

Please stay tuned for any updates as our new norm is always changing and we are always looking to improve! Once again, thank you for choosing our program.
