Who the Tractors play in the semi-finals on June 17 has been determined. **See page 8**.


OTHER LEAGUE NEWS

After being a spectator in the 2018 UHL mid-season, Sakundiak shed tears seeing his older brother Andy on the ice with his son Avrey, and also seeing his daughter Morgan Sakundiak lighting up the scoresheet. He felt now was the time for the comeback. All he needed was a team to pick him up as a UFA (Ukrainian Free Agent).


