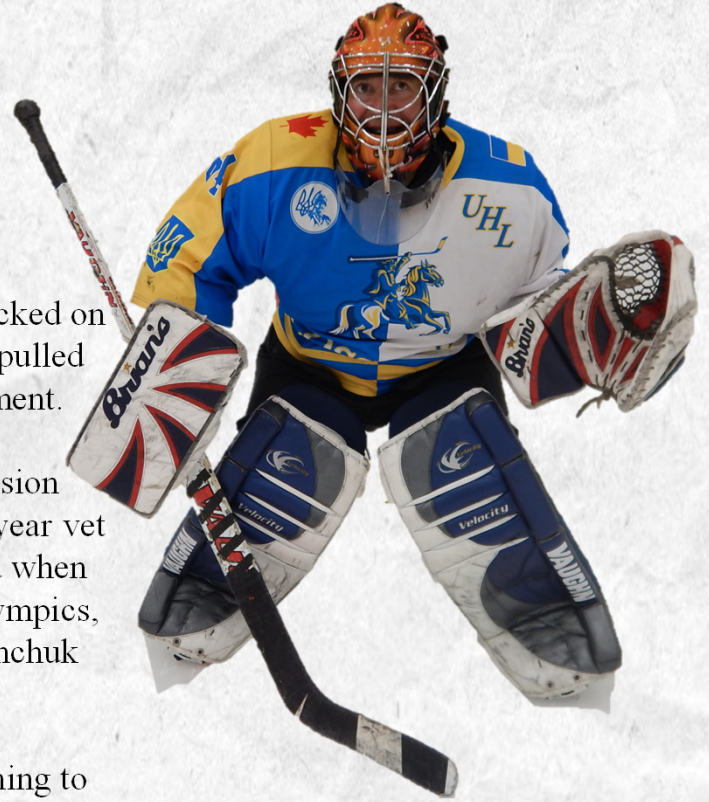

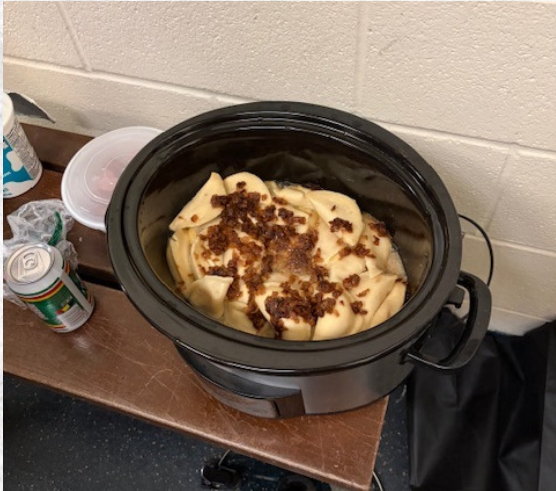

The Commish has formed a committee to do research as to why players are not viewing the site. IT professionals have now tapped into numerous players computers to force-view the site.(hint hint)

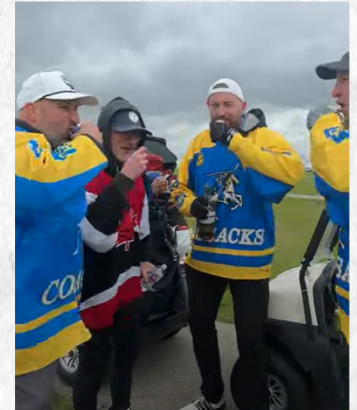

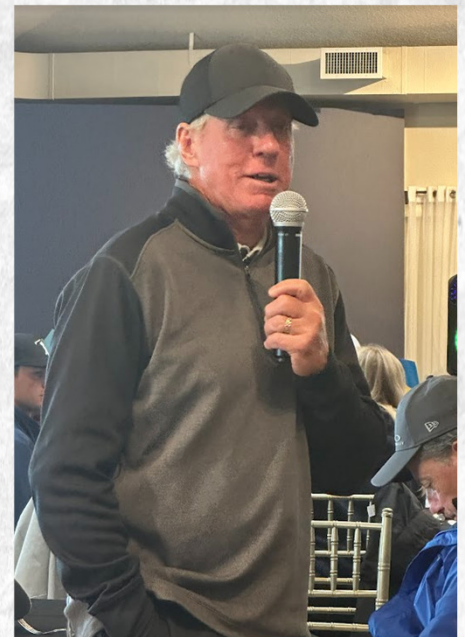

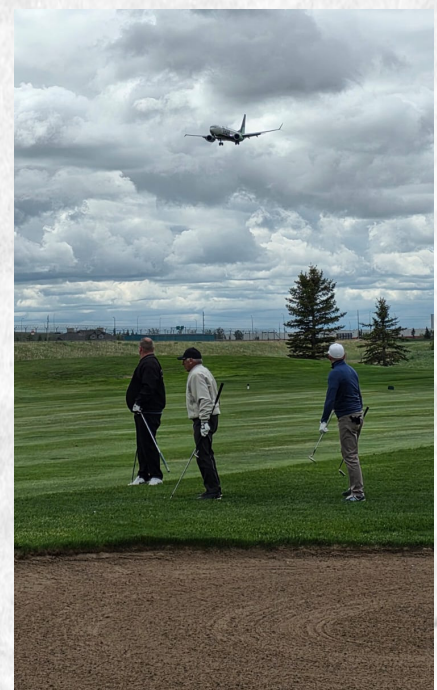
