Welcome to the big leagues Yuri!



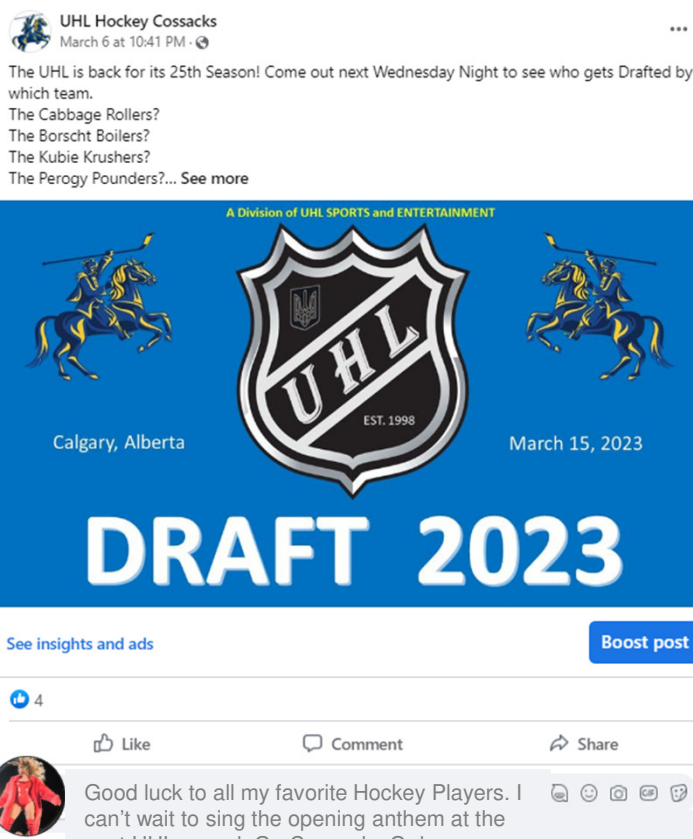

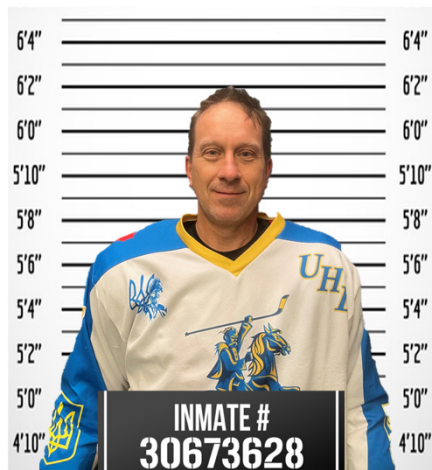
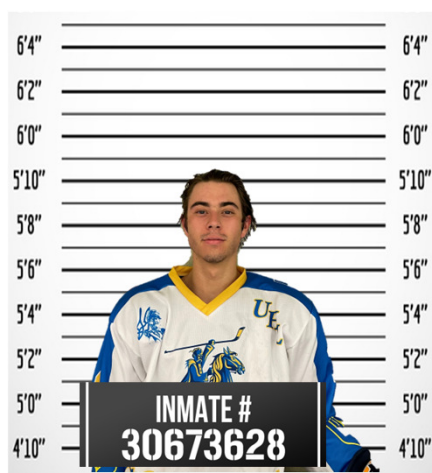
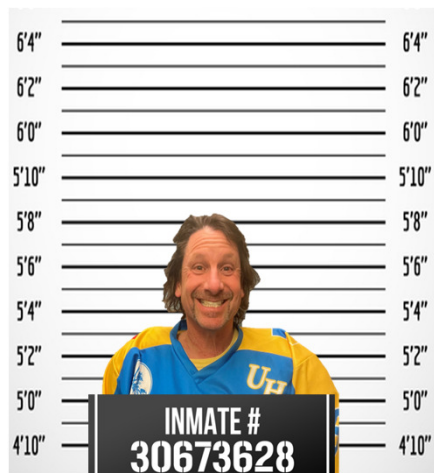
MISSING (not) IN ACTION!

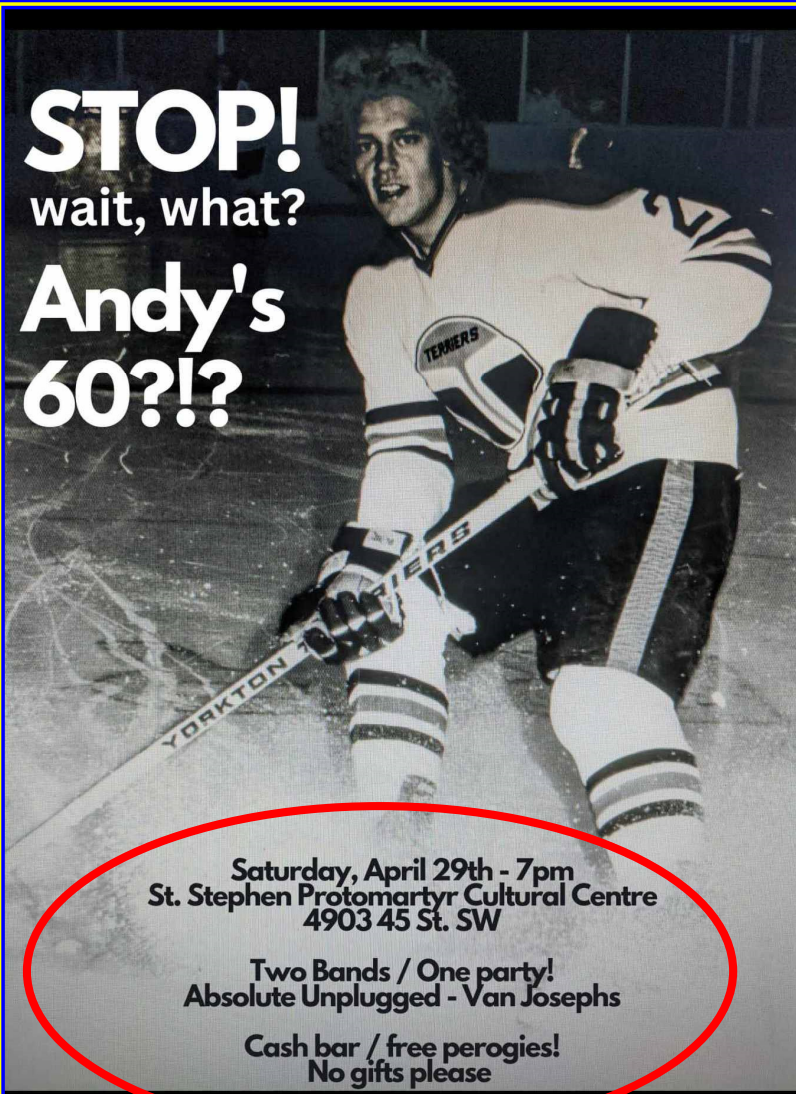

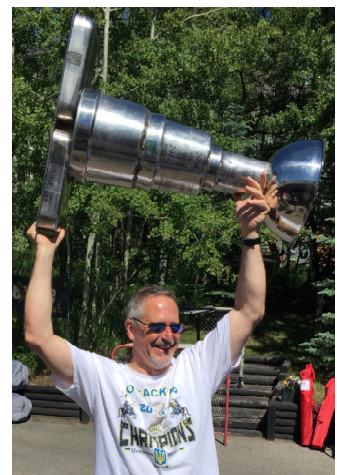
