- III. **TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer Geigle provided a copy of the report. Total assets of \$27,138.12 (report attached). Motion to approve Viverette/Callahan M/S. Motion approved.

Overview of the 2025 Golf outing: 60 golfers, approximately 15 teams with just over \$9,000 in expenses and an overall profit of \$6,751.45 (also included in the treasurer's attached report).

- V. **OTHER REPORTS:**
MACP REPORT: Executive Director Ron Wiles was not in attendance but provided the following update as presented by President Jungel:

- Winter Conference will be held on February 4-6 in Grand Rapids, MI at the Amway Grand and the registration is open.
- Robert Stevenson Conference Grant Application Deadline is November 7th
 - Small agencies (25 full time or less)
 - Haven't attended a conference before
 - Covers registration and 2 nights lodging
 - Link to the application can be found on the forums
- Deputy Director Position is posted, deadline to apply is October 24th
- Chief Mentoring Program
 - For those interested in being a mentor – application deadline is October 31st.
 - The link to the application can be found on the forums.
- Professional Development
 - Accreditation Manager Training November 6th – Plymouth
 - Spring Session of Police Executive & New Chief School: May 4th – 8th, 2026
- Legislative
 - State Budget has passed
 - Public Safety Academy Assistance Grant - \$10 million awarded
 - Public Safety Trust Fund - \$50 million awarded
 - More information to come on both of these awards
 - Police Practice STAT bills are still out there (Police Improvement Bills)
- If you haven't, it's a great time to get to know your state elected officials

MLEAC COMMISSION REPORT:

- We will have over 100 accredited agencies after the winter conference
- MACP received a COPS Office grant for \$240,000 to further enhance the accreditation program
- Mini-grants are available for smaller agencies (less than 25 full time). The mini grant covers application fee and 2 years of Power DMS. Contact Matt Silverthorn for more information.

MCOLES REPORT:

- Director Bourgeois reported that The Public Safety Academy Assistance Grants funds were approved as part of the state budget process (10 million which is lower than previous years) and the funds were sent to the Dept of Treasury. This is a change from the previous years and MCOLES will be watching and be prepared to assist when the funds are made available.
- CPE Funds were cut by 5 million so next year's disbursements will be less than the \$1,000 per FTE.
- MCOLES has added staffing which has had a positive impact on the timing of character fitness investigations but some of the investigations involving people with challenging paths may still take some time. They are trying to priorities and get the results to the requesting agencies.

Question: How will the PSTG money be handled? (Front load or reimbursed)?
Appears the department will need to front the money and be reimbursed.

Question: Grants for school resource officers? Directed to the MSP website for an answer as they handle that grant.
