**J**ohn Paul Jones is originally from New Carrollton, Maryland. He is a former Financial analyst. He graduated magna cum laude from the Catholic University of America in 2017, with a Bachelor's degree in Finance. After the finale of season six of Bachelor in Paradise, John Paul Jones and Tayshia Adams began dating again before ending their relationship once more in late October. In late 2019, he moved to Los Angeles to pursue a career in acting.

In this Q & A I asked John Paul Jones, how he went from being a Financial Analyst to, being on The Bachelorette and Bachelor in Paradise, and what attracted him to the Award winning Indie Short Film Belair Productions "Bathtub Chronicles".

**KM:** This Character is so different from the JPJ that we've seen on the reality shows. How is this character similar to you or different?

**JPJ:** Phil and I share a desire for artistic expression and self-discovery. He's different from me with respect to his lifestyle and his love life dynamic. The lad is a hippy, spends his time in pubs *doing* open mike night, couch surfs, and spends the day trying to write music. He's also the type of guy that's always in a relationship, one of those guys that's conjoined at the hip to his girlfriend.

**KM:** You studied to be a Financial Analyst. Did you work as an analyst after school?

**JPJ:** I worked for two years as a financial analyst at an education technology company called 2U before acting.

**KM:** How did you go from that to acting?

**JPJ:** The demands from traveling, collaborations, auditions, and other advertising gigs began interfering with my job as an analyst. Out of respect for the financial analyst role, I had to step aside to pursue my acting gigs.

**KM:** When did you first perform?

**JPJ:** I was in musicals from 5th grade through high school. All I could get were background roles. My first lead role came around my senior year in college when my acting professor encouraged me to audition for Drama School's fall production 'Picnic'.

**KM:** Have you had any informal/formal training?

**JPJ:** I had formal training in college and post-graduation. I enrolled in every acting class that my university offered and took classes in Hollywood.
