- a. We need to make sure the volunteers are making oatmeal cookies even though we aren't ordering any more, we need to use them up. Let's make a sign advertising that we have oatmeal cookies.

VII. VP Concessions Manager (Tara Ranson)

- a. We need to make smaller batches of cookies so we can serve warm without reheating them.
- b. The Sam's order form is in the Google drive
- c. The volunteers love the updated nacho cheese totally worth it.
- d. The warmer is starting to malfunction one shelf is not warming as well. It was bought in 2020. Do we need to have it serviced?
- e. Reusing warmed cheese let's call the manufacturing company to ask about safe practices. We can switch from using the warmer to microwave to order near the end of the shift to avoid having leftovers.

- f. Closing Melyssa, Jill, and Teresa will stay in communication.
- g. Raising the price of cookies by one dollar to \$3 for 2 cookies has been a great boost to income. Tiffany Bouska will ask outside concessions to raise their price to match.
- h. Screen not locked sounds like the key core is broken.
- i. The iPads were updated and have not been crashing.
- j. Tara is absent October 15th Tiffany Bouska will open at 3pm.
- k. Weekly cookie & hot dog tracker this is very helpful to avoid running out mid shift. Stay aware of the game schedule to know if a blowout (quick) game is expected.
- I. Choir concessions 10/25 from 5-9pm and 10/26 from 7am-3pm. They will borrow the cookie oven but they will buy their own dough. Teresa is available to work those shifts if needed.
- m. Nacho cheese and Hershey bars for teachers? We can use the Hershey bars at Christmas for a charcuterie or hot cocoa/coffee bar. Valentine's or dessert for Reward Lunch are also possibilities.
- n. Communication & future leaders how are we making sure we're setting up the team for future years? This is a bigger question for the entire PTO we have grown so much we should think about how to train and hand over our jobs. Invite people to shadow, recruitment, etc.
