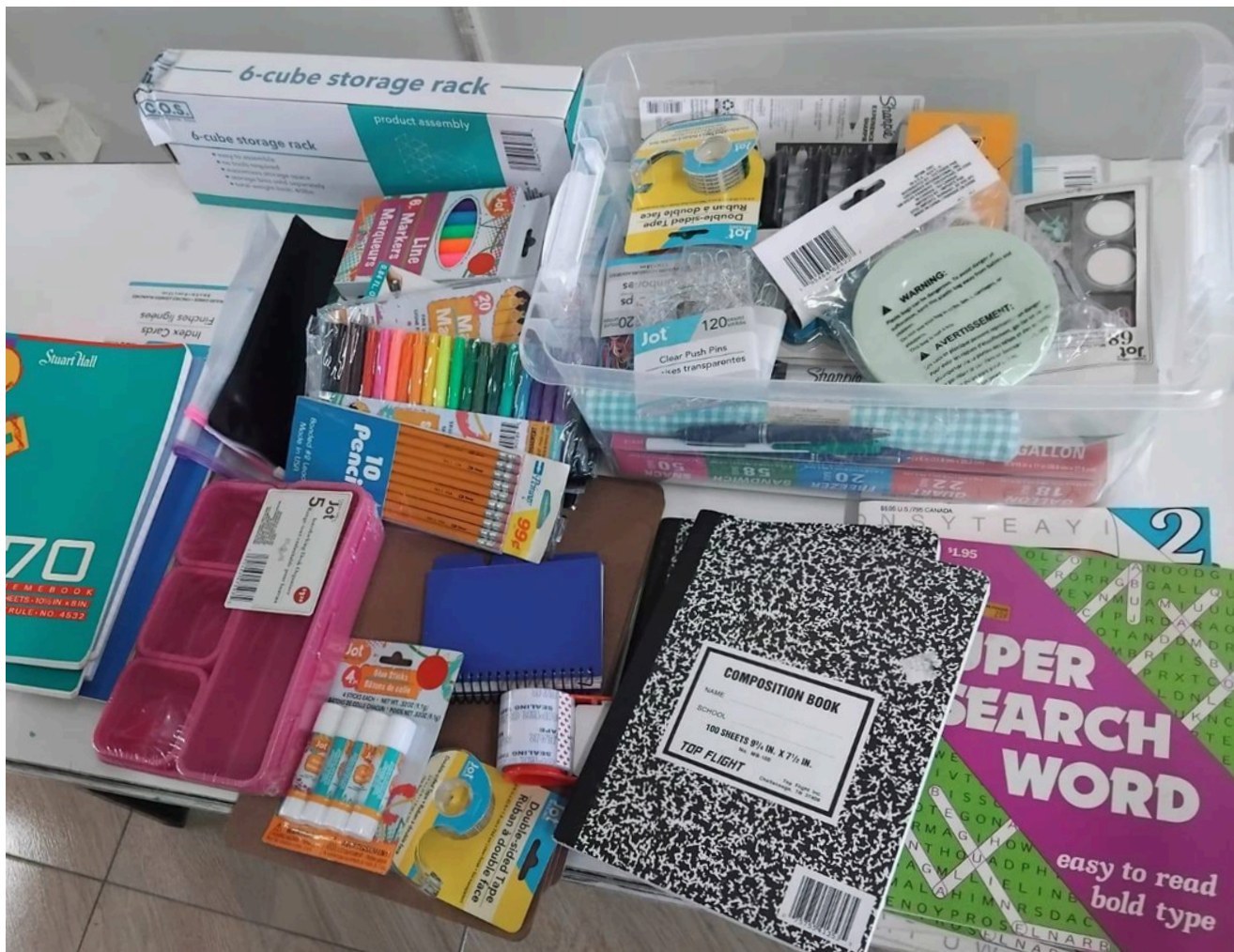

BOSTON GENEROSITY REACHES BRADES PRIMARY



Through the generosity of Montserratians living in Boston, Village664 was able to support Brades Primary School with a donation of school supplies. The contribution included exercise books, pencils, pens, crayons, rulers, glue sticks, art supplies and other classroom essentials that help students stay prepared and engaged in their learning. Teachers also received practical resources such as storage containers, filing materials, desk organisers, and other equipment designed to make their work more efficient and effective. The school leadership expressed gratitude for the initiative, emphasising how community partnerships continue to enhance education and create opportunities for young learners.



VILLAGE664 SUPPORTS ARRIVAL OF BRITISH RED CROSS DONATION

After months of coordination, Village664 successfully facilitated the arrival of urgently needed clothing items donated by the British Red Cross to the Montserrat Red Cross. Serving as liaison partner, Village664 supported logistical planning, shipment arrangements, and communication between the two to ensure the donations reached Montserrat smoothly. Before shipment, a Village664 member based in the UK inspected the clothing to confirm that the items were of good quality and appropriate for the Caribbean climate. The donations, described as summer clothing, in a variety of sizes, were carefully selected to meet the needs of families on the island. Village664 also engaged the shipping company and covered all associated transportation costs, ensuring the items were dispatched efficiently. Director of the Montserrat Red Cross expressed gratitude for the collaboration, “We thank Village 664, BRC Retail Department and all involved in enabling this shipment.”

VILLAGE664 INVESTS IN YOUTH LEADERSHIP THROUGH GIRL GUIDES CAMP IN ANGUILLA

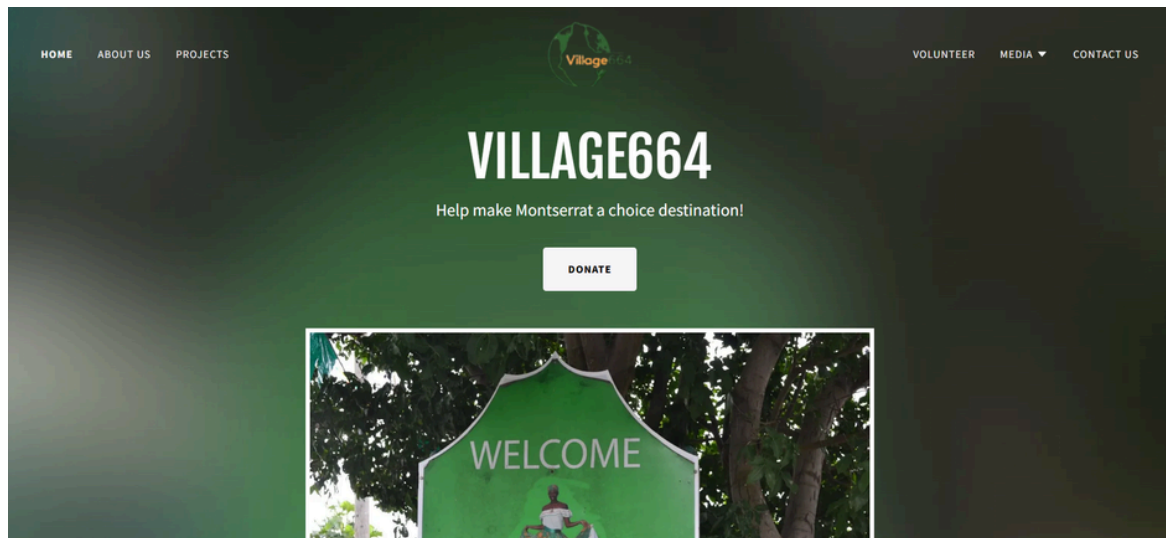

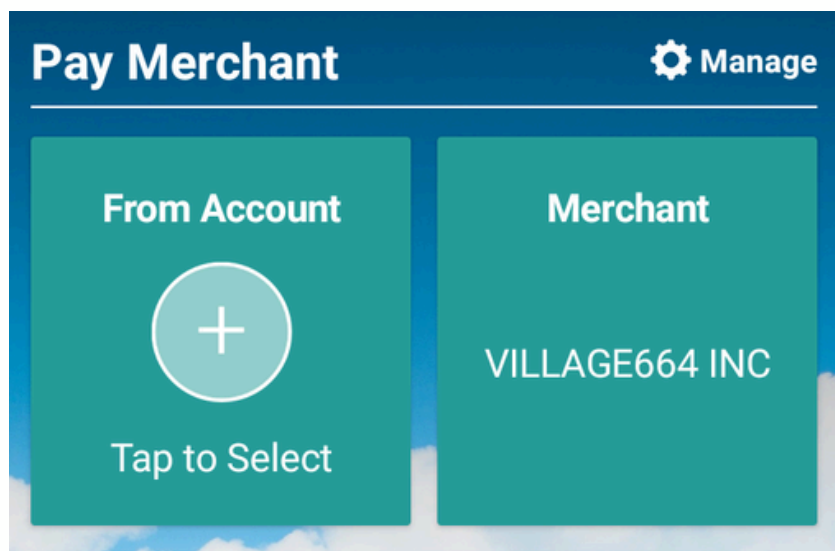
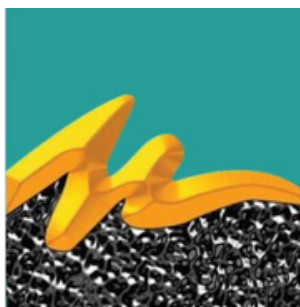
