

## Astrology of September 2025

### Overview of September 2025



At first glance, September might seem quite quiet, with just the one change of direction but closer inspection shows some very potent days with the opportunity to finish the month lighter, more authentic and on a new, clearer trajectory.

As the month begins, we have Saturn, Neptune, Pluto and Chiron retrograde and on 1<sup>st</sup> Saturn retrogrades back into Pisces reawakening karmic energies for clearing that we were dealing with in the first few months of the year. This will intensify next month when Neptune also goes back into Pisces; for now look out for old limitations or senses of lack or limitation arising and do what you can to release old patterns and anything holding you back. The Full Moon and Lunar Eclipse on 7<sup>th</sup> will be particularly helpful for this.

There are four big astrological days but with consecutive days this boils down to two pairs. Firstly on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> we have Uranus going retrograde on 6<sup>th</sup> and the Full Moon and Lunar Eclipse on 7<sup>th</sup>. Not an astrological day but also a potent energetic day, we then have the 9-9-9 portal just two days later!

The second pair of important consecutive days is the 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>, with the Blue New Moon with a Solar Eclipse on 21<sup>st</sup> followed by the Autumn (in the northern hemisphere) Equinox on 22<sup>nd</sup>, with Mars changing signs just a few hours before. The Equinox marks the beginning of the next quarter as the Sun enters Libra so the New Moon and Eclipse the day before are on the last day of the old quarter.

Neptune, Uranus and Pluto all start the month at 1° so in addition, we are still getting intense days when the faster moving planets change signs and immediately connect with these potent outer planets. On 15<sup>th</sup> September Neptune goes back to 0° and with Saturn back at the end of Pisces, first we will be shown old limitations as a planet reaches the end of a sign, then it makes the other connections at the beginning of the next sign, showing us the new energies we can embrace instead. Fast-moving Mercury changes signs twice this month so it makes these connections first on 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>, and then on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> and Venus does so on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>.

The Sun will repeat this sequence either side of the Equinox with its connection to Saturn just before the New Moon and Eclipse on 21<sup>st</sup> and after entering Libra at the Equinox on 22<sup>nd</sup> it contacts the other three outer planets on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>, finishing with two lovely, helpful trines.

The most important date to be aware of is the Full Moon and Lunar Eclipse on 7<sup>th</sup> which is a total eclipse, widely visible and with a long period of totality. As the middle of three total Lunar Eclipses in a row, this is a stepping stone on our ascension process and a time when we can release the old and welcome in powerful new energies. It offers a major reset point.

The second most important date of the month is the New Moon and Solar Eclipse on 21<sup>st</sup> is the second New Moon in Virgo, a true Blue Moon and offers a second bite of the cherry right on the last day and at the last degree of this quarter, helping to conclude this quarter and finish chapters. In some ways, it is more important than the 7<sup>th</sup> but they are a balancing pair and we have to release from the first eclipse to embrace the potential of 21<sup>st</sup>, when we have a big decision to make, as we choose our path forward and whether we are aligning to a timeline of fear or love.

The Equinoxes are times of rebalancing, with equal day and night and the chart for the moment, as the Sun changes signs, shows us the

energies and themes for the coming three months and three signs. What is most significant here is that Mars, the warrior planet, changes signs just a few hours before. The last quarter began at the Summer/Winter Solstice and Venus, its feminine counterpart was the key planet in that chart. Now we have Mars as the key component, which is extra interesting as the Sun is entering Libra, which is ruled by Venus. So we will undoubtedly continue rebalancing yin/yang, masculine/feminine energies and with Mars in the deep water sign of Scorpio, buried emotions and secrets are going to be surfacing for transformation.

At the Equinox, the Universe will lock in the decision that we made the day before and this quarter will fast forwards us on our Soul mission, as long as we stay aligned and don't let doubts or fears derail us.

With the outer planets still spanning just 2-3 degrees they have some close connections between them, but as I said last month, many of them come really close and then, due to retrogrades, widen again and won't become exact until next year. Underlying September, we have a very helpful, catalytic energy of a trine between Uranus and Pluto, the two planets of change. It comes as close as 7 minutes between 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> and then begins to widen. This is like setting sail with the optimum weather, winds and tides for your journey and adds extra emphasis to us needing to harness the currents of releasing and change that are with us. Whether we tap into these helpful forces, is up to us.

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### Daily Astrology of September 2025

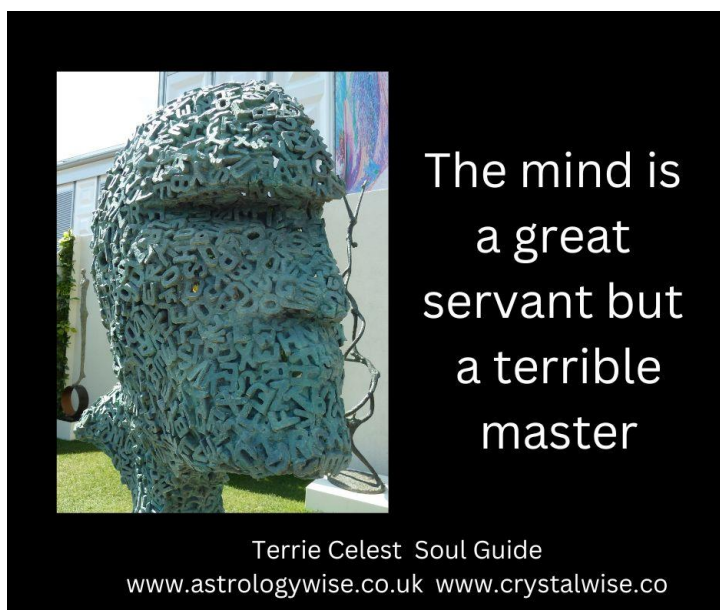
September begins with Saturn changing signs as it retrogrades back into Pisces, reawakening karmic energies for clearing that we were dealing with in the first few months of the year. This will intensify next month when Neptune also goes back into Pisces; for now look out for old limitations or senses of limitation arising and do what you can to release old patterns and anything holding you back. The Full Moon and Lunar Eclipse on 7<sup>th</sup> will be particularly helpful for this.

Old idealism, escapist tendencies and poor boundaries will also show up with many of the energies having strong karmic echoes. Look out for daydreaming, wistfulness, romanticising about what didn't come to fruition, old dreams and a general sense of nostalgia permeating like a mist into the mind. Pisces can also show us Karpman triangle dramas so

look out for victim energies arising in yourself or others and it is always worth exploring family patterns with these.

Saturn will go back to 25° 09" before turning direct on 25<sup>th</sup> November and that point correlates to 6<sup>th</sup> April so from now until 25<sup>th</sup> November it is travelling back over the part of the chart that it first covered from 6<sup>th</sup> April until 25<sup>th</sup> May, when it first entered Aries. As I said then, these last few degrees of Pisces are the last few degrees of the zodiac and offer the opportunity to release karma and step off of the karmic wheel! Whatever we clear we don't need to carry forwards with us!

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Mercury, now fast-moving, makes its first of two sign changes this month on 2<sup>nd</sup> so it is the first to activate the outer planets, having a niggly connection to Saturn at the end of Leo, then makes the same type of connection to Neptune on 3<sup>rd</sup> after moving into Virgo, moving swiftly on within the same day to a challenging square to slowing Uranus (turning retrograde on 6<sup>th</sup>) then another niggly connection to Pluto. All four of these connections occur within 24 hrs. The day finishes with a more helpful contact between Jupiter and the Nodes.

Mercury is in its second home of Virgo and whilst visiting here can clearly show us whether we are master or servant to our mind and this can directly relate to our health, with a key theme of Virgo's being to understand the mind/body link. This sign would make excellent proofreaders with the ability to spot what is out of place but this attention to small details and what is 'wrong' can turn into criticism, which can be

turned outwards or inwards. It can become a worrier and struggle to find what is 'right' or to keep positive, so we need to watch our thoughts and redirect them if they start going down the more negative routes.

Mercury repeats these quadruple connections when it changes signs again on 18<sup>th</sup>, moving into Libra, starting with challenging connections but this time ends with more helpful ones to Uranus and Pluto.

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As Uranus continues to slow, Mars is active on 4<sup>th</sup>, making a niggly connection to the Nodes and moving onto a more directly challenging square with Jupiter on 5<sup>th</sup>. Uranus' influence will likely bring frustration as we feel that things aren't as we want them to be, we can see the limitations of current situations and what is no longer authentic to us feels really uncomfortable. We want things to be different but frustration builds from feeling that we can't do anything to change outer circumstances or we could get annoyed with ourselves as we feel unable to break out of old, unhealthy or inauthentic patterns. Uranus wants us to be authentic and will highlight what isn't and can pick us up and put us down where we need to be, bringing unexpected happenings. That could happen with these energies but the frustration, showing us what does need to change is most likely to show up and its upcoming retrograde gifts us the opportunity to review those.

Mars is trying to bring some tact and diplomacy, maybe to be the go-between in disagreements but could be indecisive and buy into others' idealism. Wanting peace and harmony, it will suppress its own needs and could worry about minor niggly details that upset its equilibrium. Jupiter is going to ramp things up and could bring family matters to the fore and make us feel as if we are under fire, so it's important to keep perspective and not take things personally.

Remember that anger is a positive, helpful, warning sign that shows us that things aren't in alignment with our ideals or values but it should never be used as a weapon.

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Uranus turns retrograde early on 6<sup>th</sup> and will barely be moving at the Full Moon and Lunar Eclipse on 7<sup>th</sup>. This combination can heighten inner tension which needs to find a positive release or to be gently, internally dissipated through calming the nervous system down. Let's look at the chart first and then at the energies of the Eclipse and see how they can work together.

There was just one niggly connection the day before between the Sun and Venus which is activating energies that will evolve further on 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> and have at their core, disempowerment of the feminine. There are no exact connections on the day, nor the following day, 8<sup>th</sup>. The strong Uranus influence is key and although at first it's almost static energy seems a challenge, it is actually retrograde and this will help to bring about internal change. Uranus helps to clear old wood, what is no longer aligned with us, not authentic or is past its sell-by-date and helps to realign us to our path, which the eclipse also does.

Being an eclipse, the Nodes are near the Sun/Moon and highlight karmic energies for release associated with this axis. The Sun is sat pretty much in between Venus and Mars, the feminine and masculine archetypes, indicating a challenge between these aspects of our nature but also bringing the potential to rebalance them.

Most of the emphasis and potency comes from the eclipse itself. This Lunar Eclipse is widely visible and total for a long time as the Earth comes between the Sun and Moon and its shadow falls onto the Moon. Lunar Eclipses offer a space where energies can be reset as the natural



releasing energies of the Full Moon are ramped up. Spiritually, they act like a reboot and are catalysts for great change.

The Full Moon and Eclipse is on the Virgo/Pisces axis and has the Sun and Moon in opposite signs to the eclipse on 14<sup>th</sup> March, which was the first total Lunar Eclipse in a series of three. This is the second and middle of these three and what was initiated, instigated at the first, takes deeper root and enters more of the physical domain, becoming more tangible, accessible and achievable.

That earlier eclipse had Mercury stationary before turning retrograde, showing how there has been much emphasis on clearing old thought patterns since then. Uranus was also prominent in that chart but in Taurus and has now moved into Gemini, which is ruled by Mercury, which also rules Virgo, so all aspects of the mind and communication are being activated for a reset. Neptune was at the last degree of the chart and of Pisces and retrograde Saturn is now at that exact same point, offering a golden opportunity to release old karmic patterns of lack and limitation. So it is easy to see how this chart and Eclipse follows on, evolves from the last eclipse, both mirroring and complementing it and moving it, and us, forwards at the same time.

The Sun now in Virgo, puts the emphasis on embodying our spiritual ideals and dreams represented by the Pisces Moon, bringing them into our physical reality and the mind, body and spirit can become aligned like never before.

In the coming days and weeks, listen to and follow any nudges, intuitions and urges to improve your physical health and continue any purging of the old, physically, emotionally, mentally and spiritually. We will be shown what is not in alignment with our spiritual purpose and the Highest version of ourselves that we are stepping into.

This series of three total Lunar Eclipses act as individual stepping stones on our path and combined, take us over a threshold into new territory. The third is on March 3<sup>rd</sup> 2026. Each is encouraging:

- leaving old chapters behind
- embracing Higher guidance
- becoming the Highest version of ourselves
- releasing the old, physically, emotionally, mentally, spiritually
- bringing old cycles to a close before we begin anew

Look for the light shining through any darkness that is being presented. Keep your energies as clear and high as possible, find and stay true to your inner truth and knowing.

*Here is a suggested affirmation:-*

*I connect to my Soul and my Highest guidance.*

*I release all old versions of myself, karmic debris and all lack and limitation.*

*I open my heart and welcome in the Highest love, wisdom and abundance.*

*I fully embody my Highest truth.*

*I fully and harmoniously assimilate my physical and spiritual natures and become the Highest version of myself.*

*I step fully and willingly onto my path.*

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**The Lady Ascended Master Portia  
Custodian of the Silver Violet Flame  
and Patroness of 2025**

9<sup>th</sup> September brings the 9-9-9 portal, a very energetic and potent day. The only, and therefore very significant astrological connection on the day is a niggly one between Venus and the Nodes which follows on from the activation between the Sun and Venus before the Full Moon and Lunar Eclipse. Feminine disempowerment was at that core and the Nodes will help to show us karmic aspects of that, as well as finances, self-worth and values. We will undoubtedly still be integrating and



assimilating the energies from the eclipse. So what does this bring in addition, how can it add to and assist the energetic ripples from the eclipse?

Nine is the number of completion, the end of a cycle and in addition to the numerology, the astrology has aligned with this and offered us the opportunity to clear very old karma and step off of the karmic wheel.

The first period of this was in the first few months with a flurry of planets reaching the end of Pisces, including two big players, Neptune and Saturn who both entered Aries and are now retrograde. Saturn is now back at that last degree of the chart, 29° Pisces again and this is a big opportunity to see, acknowledge and release any form of limitation.

On the more esoteric side, the patroness of 2025, a 9 year, has been Ascended Master Lady Portia, custodian of the Silver Violet Flame, the feminine polarity of the Violet Flame, and twin flame to The Ascended Master St Germain. 9<sup>th</sup> September 2025 brings the peak of these energies, of powerful feminine energies of justice, truth and deep transformation, especially of shadow energies. The Silver Violet Flame is the flame of internal mental, emotional and spiritual alchemy and change, the ray of challenge.

Connecting to the power of the flame can empower us, helping us to clear blockages that are preventing us from feeling the love and presence of the (Mother) Divine, burning away falsity and lie to reveal the truth, thus improving our health and well-being and purifying shadow energies. Crystals that can connect us to Lady Portia and the Silver Violet Flame include Lepidolite (especially the natural with Mica) and Vera Cruz Amethyst.

I feel that the last 3 months have been encouraging us to tap into the abundance of the feminine side of our nature, to align with Source and realise what that name really means- it is the true **Source** of all abundance, which comes not from striving, pushing, trying to achieve in a masculine way, but from surrender, connection and trust.

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Mercury is sneaking up on the Sun, just behind it now, preparing to take the lead in the chart as it pass over the Sun on 13<sup>th</sup> as part of its cycle and their closeness means that for a few days they will make the same connections within a short space of time.

On 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> first the Sun and then Mercury pass over the South Node and therefore oppose the North Node. With the Nodes representing karma this very nicely continues on from the eclipse and 9-9-9 where karmic themes were showing up and offers a fantastic opportunity to put to bed some old karma, old default patterns of responding and reacting, deeply embedded karmic patterns that are past their usefulness and we have probably already identified as needing to change.

With the inclusion of Mercury, old thought patterns and beliefs can be transformed now and left behind for good! Jupiter and Venus also join in with a niggly connection on 11<sup>th</sup> and then the Sun and Mercury connect more favourably with Jupiter on 12<sup>th</sup>, hopefully bringing Jupiter's positive enhancement qualities but we will need to watch that things stay within reasonable boundaries and don't get out of control. The critical nature of Virgo, where the Sun and Mercury are residing and which Mercury rules, is what could cause most trouble, turning into worrying or focusing on what isn't 'right'. This really is where we need to ensure that the mind is the servant not the master.

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As Mercury passes over the Sun on 13<sup>th</sup> we are building to the half Moon on 14<sup>th</sup> and there is increasing background tension from Neptune who will then be back at 0° Aries on 15<sup>th</sup>, a position it first occupied in April. This brings an interesting juxtaposition with hugely contrasting natures between Saturn at the end of the zodiac in Pisces, and Neptune just a degree or so away, but at the beginning of the zodiac in Aries. These two are naturally contrasting in their nature and spheres of life and in addition, their positions represent the old and the new, the end of old cycles and the beginning of new.

Mercury leading the Sun helps thoughts to become more conscious and we can more directly act on those and steer them in a helpful direction, rather than being at the mercy of their unconscious driving.

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There are multiple connections, activations and the sense of planets getting into position before we have the New Moon and Solar Eclipse on 21<sup>st</sup> on the last day of this astrological quarter. It all feels like preparation, also stirring the pot to bring the old to the surface and trying

to clear it out of the way, ready to begin the new quarter at the Equinox on 22<sup>nd</sup>. Firstly we'll take the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> together.

On 16<sup>th</sup> Mercury, Venus and Mars come into alignment at 25° and then move on to connect with Chiron at 26° so there is undoubtedly some karma being stirred and most definitely some rebalancing of masculine and feminine. Mercury is the fastest moving of this trio and is building to a testing opposition with Saturn on 17<sup>th</sup> before changing signs on 18<sup>th</sup>. It is definitely the key planet here and sits midway between Venus and Mars as they have a potentially helpful connection, the type that we have to tap into. So Mercury, the planet of the mind and communication is supporting a rebalancing of our thoughts either around masculine or feminine issues or an inner mental rebalancing, of knowing when to use our logical and rational mind to think things through, to accumulate knowledge, or when to employ its feminine nature of the imagination, daydreaming, meditation or pondering, whose value is often dismissed against the perceived intelligence associated with the left brain. Mercury is in Virgo, which it rules, and where it is learning about discernment with its tendency to get stuck in the left brain.

When Venus and Mars move on to connect with Chiron which shows us karmic wounds, Venus has the most favourable before Mars's connection is challenging, but the feminine side of its current home of Libra will be trying to soften its battling nature and seeking to find a less aggressive, less direct or confrontational route. Look for issues with men or women who might show us these archetypal characteristics, whilst most attention probably needs to go to our mind and thoughts.

At the Full Moon and Eclipse with their Virgo/Pisces axis and with Mercury's involvement I said that *'all aspects of the mind and communication are being activated for a reset'* and that Saturn's position was *'offering a golden opportunity to release old karmic patterns of lack and limitation'*. Now, ten days later, 17<sup>th</sup>, Mercury opposes Saturn and will not only show us how our minds might be creating a sense of lack or limitation through a negative slant, it will also offer the opportunity to begin the process of putting into place, changes that we identified and want to make.

The eclipse gave us a powerful window of reset and the ability to embody our spiritual dreams and ideals, to bring those into physical reality and to align mind, body and spirit, and if we tap into the positive help of Mercury/Saturn, we can take further steps towards this and

discovering our Soul path. Anything at the eclipse that we identified, can become more solid both in our mind and practically.

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Looking at the next group of connections and changes before the New Moon we have Mercury changing signs on 18<sup>th</sup> followed by Venus and Saturn niggling, the Sun and Chiron also niggling then a testing opposition between Mercury and Neptune as a couple of ancestral patterns are formed, showing old karma that is likely to surface. Mercury has forged ahead of the Sun into diplomatic and indecisive Libra and its Neptune connection rarely brings clarity but could activate survival mode and an internal cry of – *What about me?* Look out for suppressed anger bubbling up and memories of ‘unfair’ situations which need releasing. Maybe it is time to speak our truth, to tell unspoken secrets or to let others know how we feel.

19<sup>th</sup> sees Mercury move on to a couple of more helpful connections, firstly to Uranus and then to Pluto, both of whom are planets of change. All three will be at 1° of the three Air signs and so they can help us to clear, transform, transmute what arose the day before, to change old mindsets and ingrained beliefs and clear the mind to move forwards.

Later on 19<sup>th</sup>, Venus leaves Leo and enters Virgo energies as Mercury leaves it. Thought of as the planet of love, Venus is more about how we connect to the world, our connections (relationships) and also encompasses values, finances and self-worth. Virgo’s attention to detail can help us to refine those areas of our lives, to improve them, but we need to steer away from its critical nature and also not lose ourselves in old service energies that negate the self.

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On 20<sup>th</sup> we are moving into the dark of the Moon, reactivating any old, outdated thought patterns that the combination of recent Virgo energies has highlighted. Venus is the key planet of the day having just entered Virgo as it connects with retrograde Neptune at 0°, then Uranus and retrograde Pluto at 1°, all three of which are very niggly contacts and bringing crud to the surface. Tucked in between these, Mars, Venus’ masculine counterpart also makes a niggly connection to retrograde Saturn as it reaches the end of Libra, which is Venus’ home.

So, summing this up, we have imbalances in masculine and feminine, yin and yang energies being stirred up, showing us where adjustments

need to be made and old, karmic patterns released. Where have we negated ourselves, over-compromised, or suppressed our needs out of fear of upsetting others? Or we might notice passive aggressive energies, rather than direct confrontation. In particular, look out for suppression of the feminine and where we feel a need to do battle or to act, rather than surrendering to what is. This could show us how and where we can surrender to Divine Will, accepting that everything happens for a reason and trusting the Divine/Source.

The dark of the Moon will bring shadow energies associated with Virgo, so we need to watch out for its critical, perfectionist nature and in particular, how we turn that inwards on ourselves.

Know and accept that you are perfect as you are.

The New Moon and Solar Eclipse is naturally powerful, acting as a resetting point and a point of initiation and new beginnings as the old is released. It balances the Full Moon and Solar Eclipse on 7<sup>th</sup>. In addition, this one is extra potent for five reasons.

**Firstly**, it comes after some extraordinary astrology and energetics this year, with Saturn and Neptune activating the end of Pisces then entering Aries, Jupiter and Uranus have also changed signs, these outer planets now being in the first degrees of their signs and each month creating a series of activations as the faster moving planets connect with them. And



just this month we have had the Full Moon and Lunar Eclipse and 9-9-9. This is not just an arbitrary point or day, but the culmination of many things that have brought us here now. There have been so many, I've probably forgotten to include some!

**Secondly**, this is a true Blue Moon, the second New Moon in a sign and gives us a second bite of the cherry! The first New Moon in Virgo was on 23<sup>rd</sup> August, just three hours after the Sun entered Virgo and therefore at 0°. The theme I gave for that was - *Mastery of the Mind. Make sure you are the Master, not the servant* and there has been a constant influx of energies since then, activations, clearings and shifts offering us opportunities to change mindsets and old, limiting beliefs, to clear any karma that was contributing to lack of clarity, uncertainty in ourselves and our beliefs or fuelling a lack of self-belief.

**Thirdly**, since the first New Moon in Virgo on 23<sup>rd</sup> August, there has been a major planetary change, with Saturn having retrograded back into Pisces, reactivating the end of the karmic wheel, giving us a further opportunity to clear karma and end cycles of karma.

**Fourthly**, these double Virgo New Moons also change the order of the Moons when the Sun is in a sign. Before this, when the Sun entered a new sign each month, we first had a New Moon followed by a Full Moon and from September's Sun change it will be a Full Moon before the New Moon. So this shows that we are entering a new phase where we will be experiencing and processing energies in a different order each month.

**Fifthly**, it occurs on the last day of this quarter, the day before the Equinox and is therefore bringing those new energies into place ready for us to start the new quarter after two weeks of clearing the old.

All these previous happenings this year have acted like a fast-forward on our ascension path, clearing the path, ending cycles of karma and moving us swiftly to this point where we can step fully into our Soul purpose. This is a potent culmination point and a major decision point as well.

As humans, we have free will, and this should never be underestimated. Our teams in Spirit are our biggest cheerleaders and can guide us but they can never make decisions for us and they honour our choices. They can show us doorways but it is up to us whether we open them, and whether we choose to step through them.

Back in May, when I offered free karmic healing, I mentioned that I kept seeing these parallel lines, pathways, and gave a reminder to keep remembering to step onto the new one, to leave the old karma behind. Through our actions, not just the big ones but through an accumulation of the small ones, we have already indicated to the Universe/Spirit/Source, which path we want to choose, but now we have to make a **conscious** decision to commit to the Spiritual path and timeline of our choosing.

From this point onwards, we can truly embrace what we came to do and we can use the energies of this day to bring the daydreams, the ideas, the wishes of what we would like our future Spiritual path to look like into practical alignment. This is about stepping into the Highest of Spiritual service and we can decide what that looks like.

What have you dreamt of doing in the past but dismissed with various doubts and impossibilities? To become a healer, to work with the land, to teach, to open a retreat centre, to write a spiritual book, to coach, form communities? There are endless possibilities and our own must be led by what we are passionate about, how we would like to make a difference, what we feel we could offer to do so.

*It is time to reach into the carpet bag of Spiritual dreams and pull them out, dust them off and start bringing them into reality, into fruition.*

It is absolutely no coincidence that this New Moon and Eclipse falls the day before the Equinox, when we have a day of equal day and night, a natural rebalancing point and the chart for the day shows us the themes of the coming quarter, the coming three signs and three months leading up to the Solstice on 21<sup>st</sup> December.

## Locking in your Spiritual path

The Equinox is on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2025 at 19:19 BST, being the Autumn Equinox in the northern hemisphere and Spring Equinox in the southern. It is the moment that the Sun enters Libra and the next astrological quarter begins, taking us through the signs of Libra, Scorpio and Sagittarius, up to the moment that the Sun enters Capricorn on 21<sup>st</sup> December.

The first six signs of the zodiac which begin at Aries, represent the birth and evolvment of the Soul, of the discovery of the Self, our Self, who we are, what is important to us, what we value, our passions, our thoughts and beliefs. It can be likened to the stages of birth through childhood and then we begin to venture out into the world and connect with others, where we have to learn how to relate to them and with them. We discover that not everyone was brought up in the same way as us, they might have different values or beliefs, and we begin to measure ourselves against others, to understand how we fit in and to weigh our value against others.

This is quite obviously, very relevant now and moving forwards and the divide in our societies has seemed to widen, to become polarised in some areas of our lives. The New Moon and Solar Eclipse the day before, was a powerful new beginning of being able to step into, and onto, our Spiritual service, to begin to be of the highest Spiritual service. We have made our choice, fear or love, and the Equinox takes that decision and locks it in place. The image I got was of being picked up and set down on the path of our choosing, setting us on the right trajectory. Back in May, when there was the opportunity for a lot of karmic releasing, I mentioned that I kept seeing these parallel lines, pathways or timelines, and to keep remembering to step onto the new one, to leave the old karma behind.

Through our actions, not just the big ones but through an accumulation of the small ones, we have shown the Universe/Spirit/Source, which path we choose and yesterday was the big day when we *consciously* decided; today that answer gets locked in and we begin on that path. This is the main focus of this quarter, beginning our true Soul Mission, stepping into our highest Spiritual Service.

It is vital that we don't just sit back and wait for what we want to be delivered, this isn't like a food delivery service! We have to take action, to start the ball rolling, to do things that cement our choice. To fully embrace what we came to do, we have to align mind, body and Spirit and LIVE it. We must continue to choose love, to keep an open heart, to forgive, to respond from that open heart with compassion, whatever is presented to us. Drop into your heart where you can discern truth.

Whilst Saturn continues in the last few degrees of Pisces, we will continue purging karma through to the New Year. Welcome it when you see something old arising, knowing that we really are clearing from the bottom of the barrel now, know that it is a temporary phase that will improve our vibration and make everything easier once it has passed. See it as a checklist, welcome each old echo as it arises. *Ah, there goes the last of the victimhood – tick....there goes the last of the self-doubt – tick..... there goes the last of the disempowerment – tick.....*

Whatever arises, will be able to deal with it with more speed, grace and ease and be better able to see its purpose and be excited, knowing how much better we will feel afterwards!

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The standstill and stillness of the Equinox lasts for a couple of days and 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> set us nicely on the road forwards, firstly bringing more dense energies to our attention and then on 24<sup>th</sup> there are fantastically helpful tides that we can ride like surfing champions!

When we make a big, positive decision, the energies and our enthusiasm are high and we feel invincible and then it often happens that we wake up the next morning and doubts start to creep in, or someone questions our decision or something tries to draw us back to the old, familiar energies like a magnet. These are what we will probably experience on 23<sup>rd</sup> as we come 'back to earth' from the excitement of the

New Moon and Eclipse and the Equinox. We could look on this as the first of our tests on our new pathway. The only things that can derail us are self-doubt and fear and it is vital that we release any need for external acceptance, validation or permission. We *know* we are on the right path, doing the 'right' thing, that we have made our choice for our Highest good and to be of the Highest service and it's important that we remind ourselves of that at the first sign of any wobble. Visualise stepping back onto your Highest path and regroup your energies to step forwards.

24<sup>th</sup> then brings in encouragement from the Universe, a positive, forward-thinking mindset that combines thought, imagination and transformation of any lingering doubts, patterns of negativity and limiting thoughts. Reaffirm your commitment and choice with positive affirmations and action and if you feel obstacles in your way, know that these are temporary and tests that can, and will, dissolve,

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25<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> are very quiet and this feels like a time of consolidation and integration on our new pathway. Things will start to move quite quickly once momentum is gained and this might well be noticeable after the waxing half Moon on 30<sup>th</sup>, marking the midway point between the New Moon and Eclipse on 21<sup>st</sup> and the upcoming Full Moon on 7<sup>th</sup> October. With Pluto going direct on October 14<sup>th</sup>, there is a sense of drawing our power back to us now and that would make a good visualisation if you feel uncertainty.
