



Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Recycling Program

Personal protective equipment is protective clothing, helmets, goggles, or other garments or equipment designed to protect the wearer's body from injury or infection.

Here are some common types of PPE used in the healthcare, biotech, medical manufacturing and electronics manufacturing:

1. **Gloves:** Protect the hands from exposure to harmful substances or infections. These are typically made of latex, nitrile, or vinyl, and are used for various tasks, including patient care and laboratory work.
2. **Masks:** These cover the nose and mouth to protect the wearer from inhaling infectious agents, dust, or harmful chemicals.
3. **Safety Glasses and Goggles:** These are used to protect the eyes from splashes or sprays of body fluids or harmful substances. They can be used in combination with masks or respirators for more comprehensive protection of the face.
4. **Gowns and Aprons:** These provide protection for the body and clothes from exposure to infections or harmful substances. Gowns are typically long-sleeved and cover the entire body, while aprons provide frontal protection.
5. **Hairnets and Caps:** These are used to cover hair, protecting them from exposure and helping maintain a sterile environment.

Shoe Covers and Booties: These are used to cover shoes, protecting them from exposure and helping maintain a sterile environment.

We accept PP Woven and Tyvek Gowns. We accept gowns with ties, fabric cuffs, velcro closures and plastic zippers. WE CANNOT ACCEPT GOWNS WITH METAL ZIPPERS.

Hair Nets



We accept PP Woven and Tyvek Hairnets. We accept hairnets with elastics, ties and fabric edges.

Booties



We accept PP Woven and Tyvek Booties. We accept booties hairnets with elastics, ties and fabric edges.

Safety Glasses



We accept all types of rigid plastic safety glasses.

Goggles



We accept all types of rigid and flexible plastic safety goggles.
