A regular meeting was duly called to order by mayor Perkins at 6:00 p.m. Councilmembers present Wayne Walter and Terry Muller. Absent Lon Oelke and Tiffany Marlin. Also present: Travis Winter of Bolton & Menk, Sharon Rosen of the Sentinel Newspaper, Angie Ziemer, Armin & Barb Kronback, Jim Plumhoff, Nate Beckendorf – City Works and Mary Muller City Clerk Treasurer.

Consent Agenda: August Minutes, August Financial Report and September Bills. Motion by Walte and seconded by Muller. Carried 3-0.

Public Comment: No Comments

Council discussed the Data Request Policy. Tabled until next meeting. Motion was made by Walter and seconded by Muller to approve the Agenda Policy. Carried 3-0.

Council discussed the proposed levy for 2026. The proposed levy was set at \$238,215.00 by Resolution 2025-7. Motion by Muller and seconded by Walter to approve Resolution 2025-7. Carried 3-0.

Council accepted a bid of \$2,000.00 from Crown Tree Services for the removal of a damaged tree by city hall, Motion by Walter and seconded by Muller. Carried 3-0.

Motion was made by Walter and seconded by Muller to approve the excavating expense for inspection of county tile that may be plugged. Carried 3-0.

Councilmen Muller reported on the Fire Association; they are still looking into funding for new radios. He also stated they were looking into a power washer too. Council men Walter asked City Works employees to get the rock down at the ponds before winter. He also asked about the rag catcher for the lift station. That will be installed at the east lift station. Mayor Perkins asked council to read the Chapter 2 of the ordinance book. She asked council if any changes were needed to contact her.

There being no more business it was motioned by Walter and seconded by Muller to adjourn. Carried 3-0. Adjourned 6:55 p.m. Next regular scheduled council meeting will be held on October 14, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. in the council room. The next work session will be held on September 23, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.
