1. Is this something that will glorify God? 1 Corinthians 10:31
2. Will this be a stumbling block or a stepping stone for others? 1 Corinthians 8:9
3. Does this benefit and promote growth? Hebrews 12:1
4. Am I making this decision out of sadness, hurt, or anger? Psalm 37:8
5. Do I feel pressured or rushed to make a decision? Psalm 40:1
6. Does it create peace or confusion? Colossians 3:15
7. Is it worth imitating? 1 Corinthians 11:1
8. Is there biblical precedent to support my decision? Psalm 89:34
9. Have I sought or received godly counsel? Proverbs 11:14
10. Would I want to be doing this if Jesus returned right now? Matthew 24:44
