

# Water Baptism

Matthew 28:19-20

Baptism = from the Greek word *Baptiso* – to be fully immersed and completely covered, to be buried

## Three Different Baptisms

1. Salvation, Ephesians 4:5; Romans 6:3-7; Galatians 3:27-29
2. Water Baptism, Acts 1:5; John 20:22
3. Baptism of the Holy Spirit, Matthew 28:19

## Five Facts of Water Baptism

1. Baptism is an act of obedience, Acts 2:33-39
2. Baptism is a sign of commitment, Galatians 3:27
3. Baptism has to be done the way that Jesus taught it, Matthew 28:19

Name of the Father represents sonship

Name of the Son represents partnership

Name of the Holy Spirit represents fellowship

4. Jesus was baptized so we follow His example, Luke 3:21-22
5. Baptism is a way for you to conform more to the Lord, Romans 12:1-2
