Our Weekend Away at Home

Church Weekends Away have always been very special times, with the chance, not just to hear from good speakers and focus on our relationship with God, but to do this together, in a more relaxed setting, when we can share together and get to know each other better. In the past these things were a regular part of many churches' programmes – however, in recent years with rising costs and changing lifestyle patterns, quite a few churches have found these more difficult to organise. One way round this is to do a special weekend that is near to home, which cuts down on travelling and costs, and also makes it more flexible for people. We have organised one of these before, a few years ago – and we are having another one – 13^{th} – 15^{th} June.

However, this time it's going to be slightly different – we're planning it jointly with some other churches - St Paul's and St Bart's, and Kirby and Great Holland. There are a few reasons why I think that working together like this is a good idea (for this weekend and other things).

Firstly, we can do some things together that we would struggle to do as well separately. I'm hoping this weekend will be bigger and more encouraging because we're working together and sharing resources.

Secondly, all of these churches and their leaders share a similar vision to teach from and live by the Scriptures, to share the Good News with others and be a blessing to the community. I'm hoping that, as we mix together, we can encourage and help each other in this task.

Thirdly, in these troubled times in the Church of England, it is important that churches with this shared vision are able to stand together – getting to know each other helps us do this.

Finally, simply mixing with a bigger, more varied group of Christians, to learn from and worship God, will be a great encouragement to us all in our own Christian lives. I'm certainly looking forward to praising God with everyone else on the Sunday morning.
