Are you having a receiving line?  Who will be in the receiving line?  Where is it located?
Will there be a host or hostess at the Reception:
Will you have ushers?  If so, will they usher each row or just the family?
Where is the Reception?

Do you want the Officiant to do a blessing on the food at the Reception?
What are the wedding colors?
Date to have ceremony ideas together by? (Usually about 3 months ahead is best; it gets hectic otherwise)
