Who We Are

The Mission of Yahweh is a faith-based shelter that has been empowering, enriching, and restoring the lives of homeless women and children and providing outreach services to low-income communities since 1961. We are a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization.

What We Do

The Mission of Yahweh offers shelter and many life-changing programs focused on ending the cycle of homelessness and dependency.

How We're Funded

The Mission is supported by contributions from the private sector, foundations, and grants. We do not accept any government funds. Contributions can be made for specific projects or for general expenditures.

An independent audit is conducted on an annual basis and is available on request.

Fast Facts

- Members are elected to three (3) year terms and can choose to serve a second consecutive three-year term.
- We hold regular meetings 6 times a year, and an annual strategic planning meeting in August.
- In addition to regular meetings, Board members attend committee meetings and support Mission activities and events.
- Our annual strategic planning retreat is held in August.
- We develop and administer Strategic plans in four committees that work in partnership with the Mission's staff. Our committees are:
 - Development
 - Facilities and Technology
 - Programs
 - Board Governance and Human Resources
- We ask each Board member to serve on at least one committee.

The Board exists to:

- Determine the mission and purpose of the organization.
- Select and support the Executive Director and assess his or her performance.
- Ensure effective organizational planning and adequate resources.
- Determine and strengthen the organization's programs and services.
- Enhance the organization's public standing.
- Ensure legal and ethical integrity and maintain accountability.
- Recruit and orient new Board members.
