

The Montebello Unified School District ("MUSD") serves the residents of Montebello, Bell Gardens, Commerce, and portions of Monterey Park, Pico Rivera, and Rosemead, as well as the unincorporated areas of South San Gabriel and a part of the unincorporated community of East Los Angeles. Founded over 100 years ago, and with 23,000 students, MUSD is one of the largest school districts in Southern California.



The Friends of MUSD Foundation ("Friends") was formed nearly 10 years ago by local community and business leaders and former MUSD employees to provide scholarships to graduating students and to offer financial support for the needs of students not met through the MUSD budget. Independent of the MUSD, Friends is a tax exempt 501(c)(3) charitable foundation.
