What are Family Recovery Support Services?

Family recovery support services connect people who are living with the substance use disorder of a loved one, with a trained Certified Family Recovery Specialist (CFRS), an individual who has lived experience coping with the substance use disorder of a loved one and has found long-term recovery independent of the recovery status of their loved one. They offer one-on-one support, encouragement, and guidance, helping family members learn to prioritize self-care, set boundaries & focus on their own recovery while still supporting their loved one's recovery process as well.
