CONDITIONS GOVERNING GIFTS TO BLAISDELL FAMILY NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

The Deed of Gift form represents an agreement between the Blaisdell Family National Association and the person or persons named on the face of the form. Any variation from the terms listed on the face of the form and below must be in writing upon the face of the Deed of Gift.

1. Gifts to the Blaisdell Family National Association shall be recorded as unrestricted donations and the Blaisdell Family National Association shall have the right to utilize donated property in the manner which best serve the Blaisdell Family National Association and its collections. Acceptance does not imply that donations will be put on permanent display. Unless otherwise noted, all copy and literary rights are conveyed to the Blaisdell Family National Association.
2. Acceptance of gift is to be accepted by the Blaisdell Family National Association, during the waiting period temporary custody of gift item is assumed by the Blaisdell Family National Association.
3. Gifts to the Blaisdell Family National Association are tax deductible from taxable income in accordance with the provisions of Federal income tax laws. However, Blaisdell Family National Association board members and volunteers CANNOT, in their official capacity, give appraisals for the purpose of establishing tax deductible value of donated items. For protection of the donor, the Blaisdell Family National Association recommends an appraisal by a qualified appraiser before title to property is conveyed to the Blaisdell Family National Association.
4. The donor(s) named on the face of the Deed of Gift form is assumed to be the legal owner of the property conveyed or his/her designated legal agent. The Blaisdell Family National Association does not knowingly accept donations offered by someone other than the rightful owner.
