All students interested in auditioning for *Melissa Tunes In* will need the following items (included in this packet).

- 1. Monologue selection (ONE of the selections memorized for audition)
- 2. Audition form (Filled out and turned in on the day of their audition)

ALL MATERIAL MUST BE MEMORIZED FOR AUDITIONS.

- There will be a sign-up sheet in the Chorus room for all interested students starting on Wednesday, August 14th at 2:00 pm.
- Any student who attends PJHS may audition for the show, regardless of whether or not they are enrolled in chorus or drama.
- Interested students should choose a five minute time slot on <u>ONE</u> of the two audition days.
- ALL AUDITIONING STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO STAY AFTER SCHOOL. Just because you sign up for a specific time does not mean you won't be called before that time. The sign up sheet is a suggested order, not a fixed timetable. All students will be done auditioning by 4 pm.
- Once a student is done auditioning, they are free to leave to go home.
- My goal is to post a cast list by Thursday, August 22nd or Friday, August 23rd

Monologue Option #1 (female)

(from "Melissa Tunes In")

[MELISSA]

(She looks warily over at the audience. Melissa approaches, not sure of the boundaries of her imagination)

Get out of my room! This...this is not my family. I have a single mom, no brothers and sisters, and I have a dad that doesn't live here because he left us so he can play bit parts on TV shows that don't last more than three episodes and movies so bad they're impossible to find at the video store because they suck which is really, really, totally stupid. Most of all, my life doesn't have an audience because it sucks. It's not a TV show...it's real, it's boring and it's not funny....(AWWW signs flash, the audience feeling sorry for her.) Stop it! Go away! Leave me alone! ... I want to be more than these four walls. I want you to help me. I want to break out of my character. I know children go to bed hungry. I know there's pain and war and sadness in the world. I can't ignore and live in a TV show. I want to do something about it. The world is so different outside these four walls, mom. I want to be different, too.

[Fritz (50's TV show little brother)]

Who are you talking to? I heard you talking to somebody. There's nobody here. It troubles me, sis. You're talking to the TV again, aren't you? You talk to the toilet when it doesn't go down all the way. What's a little brother for? Check it out *(Fritz walks over to Telly and looks him over.)* Personally I prefer idiot programming because it soothes the savage beast and limits the imagination...just what we need in these troubling times...Don't worry mom, she's just giving you a hard time...Jeez Melissa, you forgot how to have a good time, you jerk. No wonder you don't have any friends and wallow in ignorance. *(He puts his arm around Pee-Wee.)* C'mon Junior. You didn't mean for it to be personal? That's the problem, M. It's all personal. I do it for laughs. You actually mean it. You know when they say, life's not always about you...well, it is. Whatever you say, whatever you do. Whatever you don't say, whatever you don't do.
