

CV LINK IS COMING TO YOUR AREA

STARTING IN APRIL 2024

NORTH PALM CANYON DRIVE TO E. VISTA CHINO ALONG THE WHITEWATER RIVER STORMWATER CHANNEL

The Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG) is building the next segment of CV Link in the City of Palm Springs from Highway 111 to E. Vista Chino. Construction crews will construct a concrete pathway along the top of the Whitewater River Stormwater Channel levee.

CV Link is a 40-plus mile pathway that is being built across the Coachella Valley to provide a safe route to walk, run, bike or use low-speed electric vehicles, such as golf carts.


CV Link is expected to provide significant environmental, public health, and economic benefits to generations of current and future residents and visitors to our valley.


