


same commitment to content important to our residents. This quarterly publication supplements other more time sensitive information that is shared on our social media platforms and via email alerts.

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Prescott Preserve Update

The Palm Springs City Council voted 4-0 (with one recusal) to approve a minor amendment to the landscape plan for the former Mesquite Golf Course clearing the way for Oswit Land Trust to finally begin improving the land and applying for a \$7.2M state restoration grant.

While the lawsuit with Mesquite Country Club HOA and Oswit is still on-going relative to the land that MCC leases from Oswit, this important approval was necessary for Oswit to removed dead trees, plant new landscaping and have city approval in hand for the Wildlife Conservation Board's meeting later this year.

Many LBHNO residents have yard signs supporting the preserve and/or wrote letters of support for Oswit - both for the minor landscape amendment and the grant. Our board, representing our collective interests, did the same. Copies of those letters are

available on our website.

Street Repairs




Special Event at The Shag House


