



Annual Meeting Summary

Little Beverly Hills Neighborhood Organization

April 2025

For those neighbors who were not able to attend our annual meeting on Saturday, the LBHNO Board wanted to provide a summary:

1. Various city officials including Mayor Pro Tem Naomi Soto, City Manager Scott Stiles, PSPD Chief Andy Mills and PSFD Chief Paul Alvarado provided updates about city government and projects.
2. LBHNO has made a total of **\$32,500 in charitable contributions in 2025** as follows:
 - \$20,000 Oswit Land Trust to benefit the Prescott Preserve
 - \$2,500 PS Modernism Committee to benefit a student scholarship
 - \$2,500 PSUSD Foundation to benefit a student scholarship
 - \$2,500 Find Food Bank to benefit the food bank at St. Theresa's Church
 - \$2,500 Do The Right Thing Palm Springs honoring children who make a local impact
 - \$2,500 PSPD Officer's Fund in honor of Patrolman Gale Eldridge (early LBH resident)
3. The Board discussed a potential application for the Enchanted Village Historic District (the 64 Alexander Construction Company homes in our neighborhood). Additional information is on our [website](#) with community meetings to be scheduled in the fall.
4. The Oswit/MCC lawsuit has been settled allowing Oswit to apply for the restoration grant for the Prescott Preserve. The project is expected to take 3 years (from now) to complete.
5. Look for 2025-2026 Season events to be announced in the late Summer.
6. Board Elections: Rod, Rob, Bill and Brian were all re-elected to their roles. Randi Merel replaces Meredith Gardner (who decided not to seek reelection) as Secretary. We thank Meredith for her service for the last several years!
