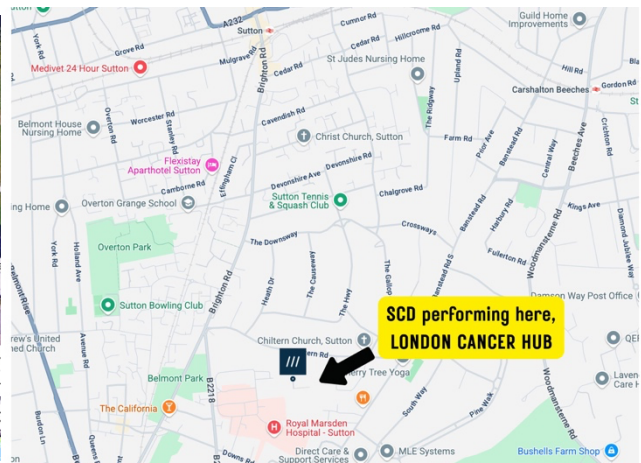

3.30pm final departures

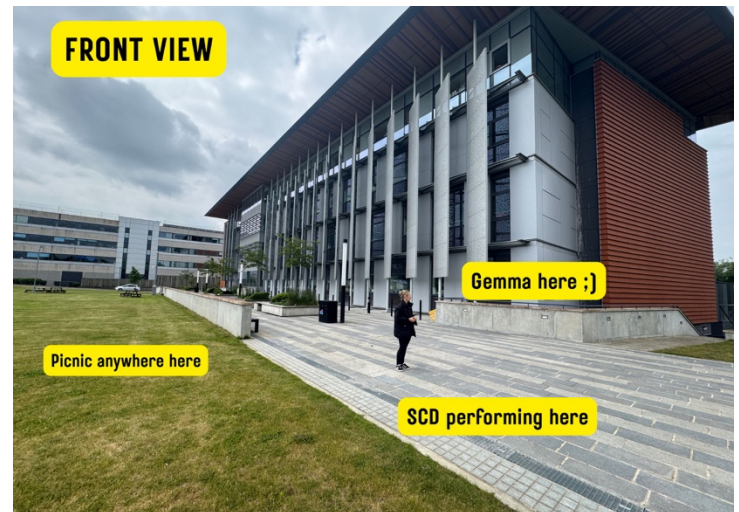
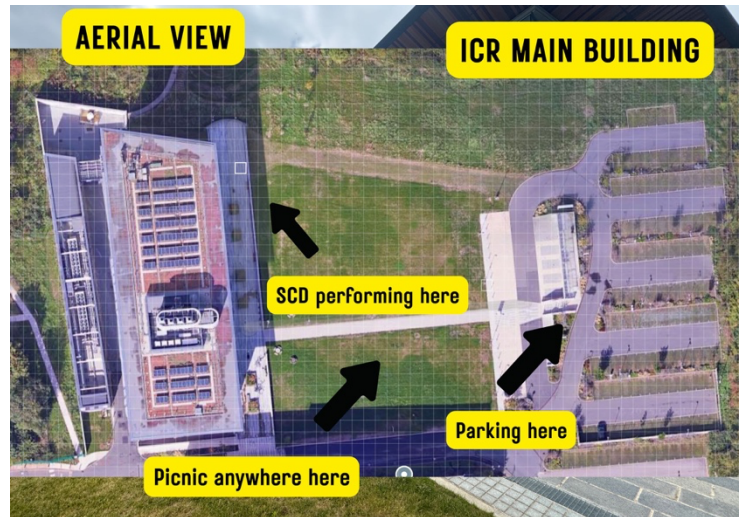
REFRESHMENTS & FACILITIES
