


Exodus 3:18—Moses asked Pharaoh to let Israel go 3 days journey into wilderness to worship God.

Jesus' Final hours and SIX Illegal Trials



In Genesis Chapter One, God sets forth His creation thus, "Evening and the morning..." The evening comes BEFORE morning.

In Exodus 12:6 the Passover Lamb was to be killed in the EVENING. The Hebrew for this means "between the evenings." i.e. Evening begins with the sun starting its decline and continues through sunset. So, God reckons a day beginning at 12:00pm and ending at 11:59am. That is how Jesus was our Passover Lamb and was crucified Tuesday at 9:00 am, the time of the morning sacrifice. Then while hanging on the cross, Wednesday begins at 12:00pm and Jesus died at 3pm, the time of the evening oblation, also the middle of the 70th week of Daniel 9:27.
