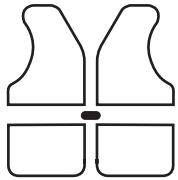

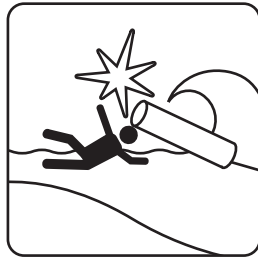
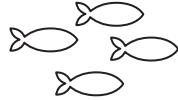
**DANGER

Ocean currents are dangerous at any time of the tide. You cannot swim against these currents.



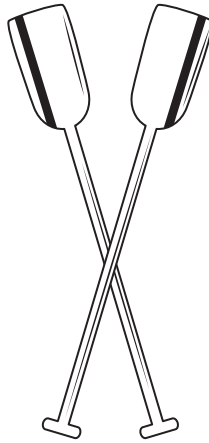
Wear a life jacket when playing near the water's edge.



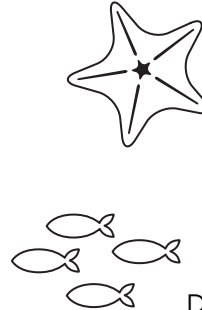
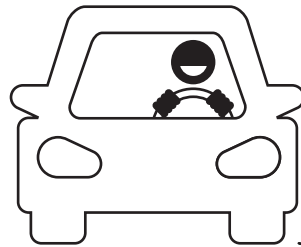
Stay away from logs in surf or wet sand.



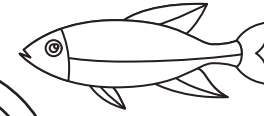
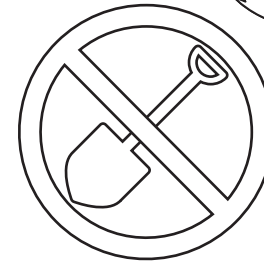
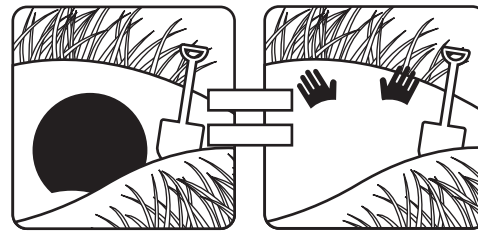
Attempting a rescue in the ocean is very dangerous! You will likely become a victim yourself! Call **911** and stay there!



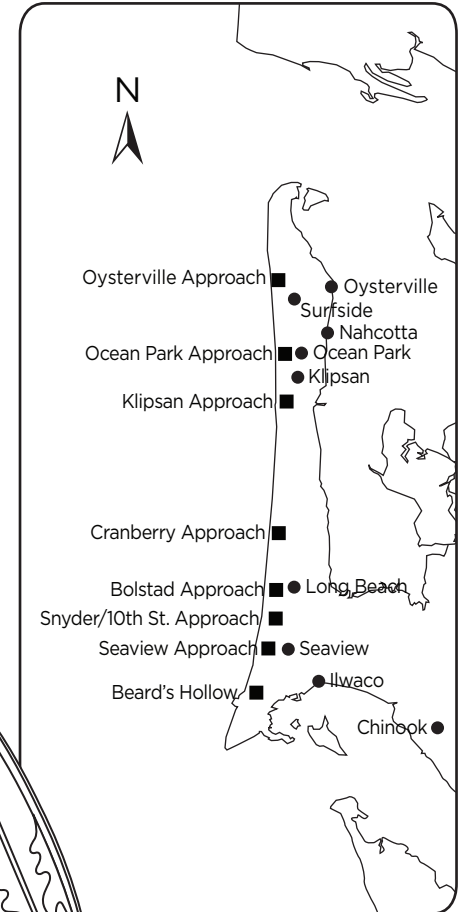
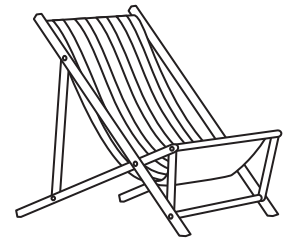
Obey the maximum speed limit of 25mph.



Don't dig caves in the dunes. Tunnels and caves will collapse and bury you!



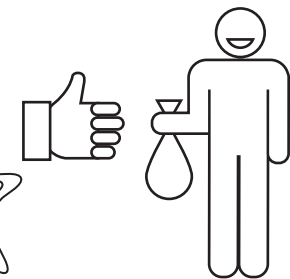
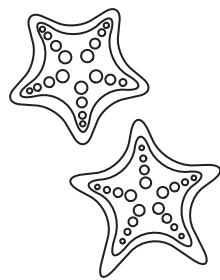
**BEACH  
APPROACHES**



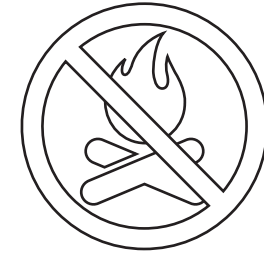
Stay away from wildlife, dead or alive. Leave wildlife alone.



Cliffs and rocks are not suitable for climbing.



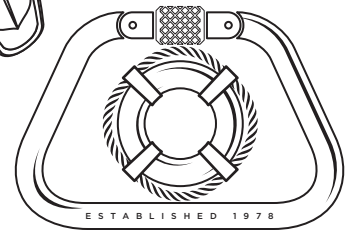
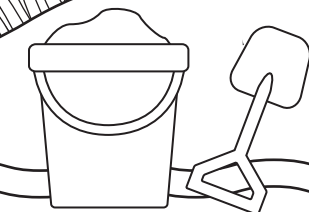
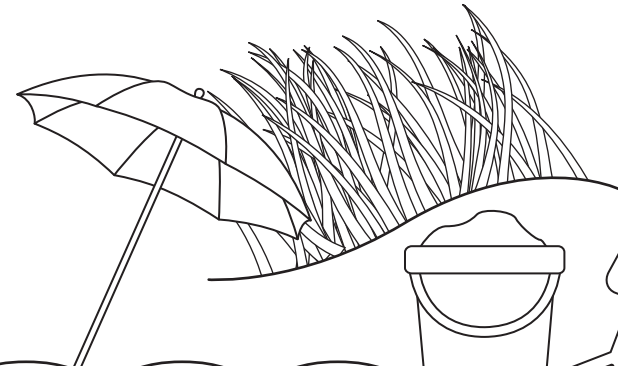
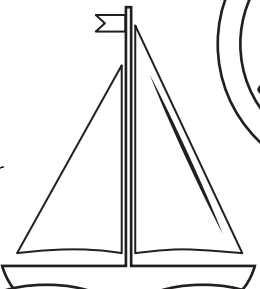
Pack out your garbage.
