Coochiemudlo Island - 18th and 19th July 2026

PLAN A: Weather and winds permitting Coochie is a great place to anchor and explore! If winds are not favourable, PLAN B would be to leave your boat at home and catch the ferry on Sat morning for a Whittley catch up with friends over lunch at the Beach Bar.

FRIDAY 17th

If you launch from Raby Bay, there is a good anchorage on the Cleveland foreshore where you can tender ashore and walk to Raby Bay harbour. Alternatively, anchoring at Peel Island is a good option.

SATURDAY 18th

Options for launching the boats on Saturday morning are Raby Bay or Manly. You could use the VMR boat ramp at Victoria Point (**make sure the tide is high as it can be very shallow**) and it is only a short trip over to the island. We will anchor on the southern side of the passenger ferry jetty which is also out the front of the Beach Bar.

Option to explore the Flinder's Day markets and family fun day on Coochie from 9am. Some of our members may be in disguise so keep a look out!

We will book some tables for lunch at the Beach Bar for 12.30pm, so please let us know if you would like to be included in the booking (txt Julie 0403 006 248 or email bosgratj@gmail.com or RSVP on FB)

The afternoon is for relaxing.

We will meet on the beach in front of our boats for 'sundowners' at 4.00pm.

Dinner will be self catered on your boat but you will have option to dine out if you wish.

Self cater breakfast onboard or option to dine at Curlew café.

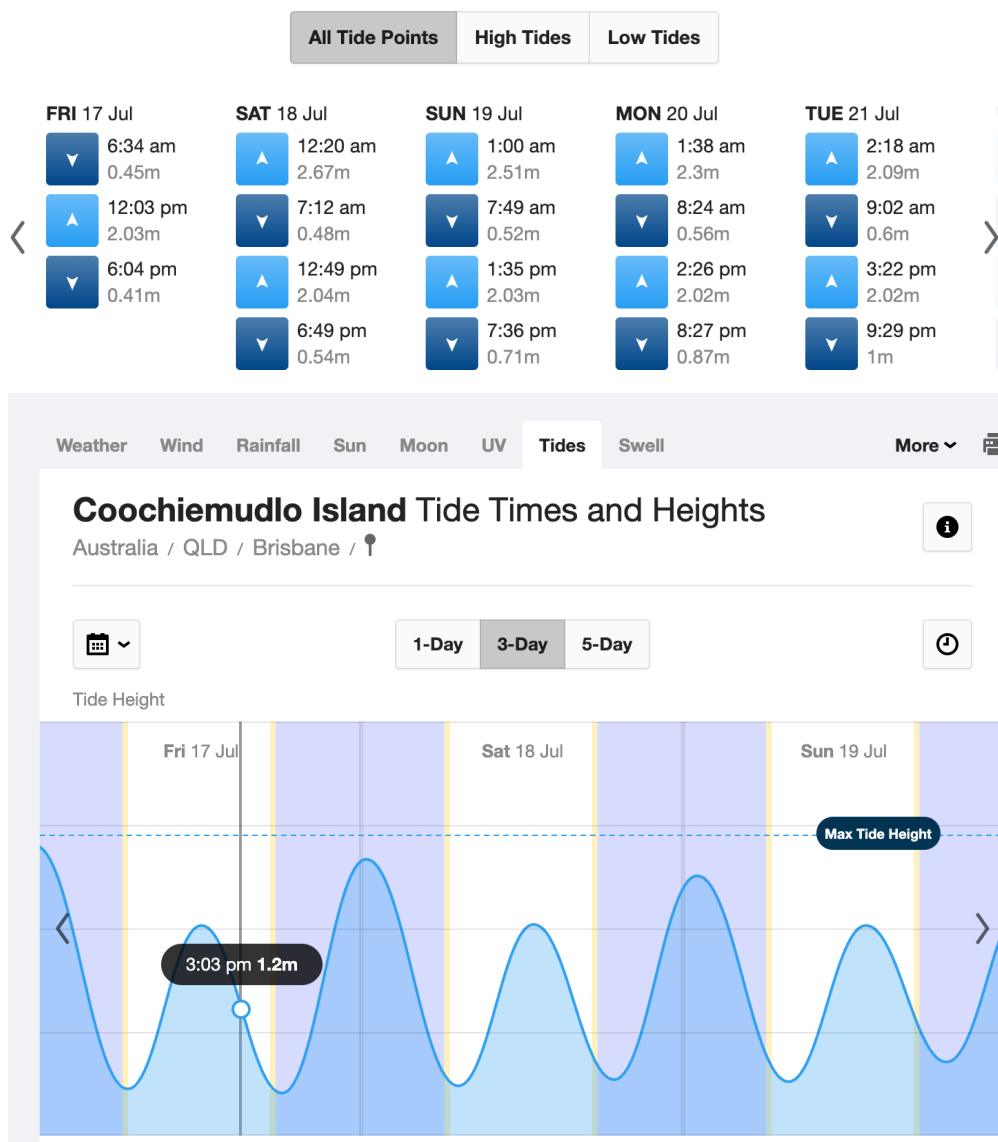
Around 9am those wanting some exercise can join us in circumnavigating the island on foot! We may end up at the golf club for a bite to eat if they are serving before heading back to our boat.
