Enjoy a relaxing weekend of good company, nature, stunning sunsets & a warm campfire.

‘Spring’ into action for this September club trip. It is in our own backyard on a beautiful subtropical island of which over 70% is natural reserve and abounds with wildlife (not quite the Whitsundays, but much closer)

FRIDAY 11TH

Blue Pearl will be launching from D’Albora Pacific Point Marina, 80 Cabbage Tree Point Road, Steiglitz (formally Horizon Shores Marina) at around 10am on high tide which is ideal for this ramp. It is a secure gated site costing \$25 launch fee + \$10 per extra night. Scan the QR code at the boat prep area to pay. It has one double sided pontoon to launch but no courtesy pontoons currently available. Fuel is available on a pontoon near the café.

Jacobs Well public boat ramp is another launch option nearby and has a large trailer park, good wide ramp with pontoon and an adjacent courtesy pontoon. There are security cameras on site and a great tackle shop.

Jacqui and I are setting up Base Camp for the trip on site 'F' of the Tippler's camp site.

- Lunch: Tippler's Café or self catered.
- Sunset drinks: 4pm at Base Camp 'F' with campfire.
- Dinner: Self catered or camp BBQ's available.

SATURDAY 12TH

- 8am: early walk across island to get the blood pumping (after coffee and such). See who can get the best surf side selfie with the GC skyline in the background. Brekky self catered.
- 11am: Brunch/lunch – Tippler's Café. After lunch there will be a Pool and/or Table Tennis challenge for the competitive ones.
- 4pm: Sunset drinks and campfire at Base Camp 'F'; followed by a sausage sizzle BBQ provided by the Club.

SUNDAY 13TH

Breakfast options: self catered, at the café or use the camp BBQ facilities.

Late morning, on the high tide, we'll take a short cruise north to Millionaire's Row or Jumping Pin. Lunch on board at this anchorage and maybe a swim or a fish to be had.
