

Big Note, don't trust the routing, make sure you keep a close eye on your depth sounder at all times, and idle at shallow points, especially coming into Koorinal, high tide is at 11.46am Please note – all beacons have been removed from the Rouse channel leading into the Mt Cotton reach & Black Gutter, if you have a track marked in your chart plotter this shouldn't be an issue on a higher tide.

(remember the skipper is always responsible so please take due care)
