IF 2022 IS CORRECT, THEN, PERSECUTION STARTS DURING THE FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD IN 2023

Hello Friends.

I think it's important to revisit an important concept in the 18-page study I emailed you on August 30, 2022, entitled: "An Urgent Appeal | Corrections To The Year 2022 & My Series (Leviticus 16, The Sealing, The Close of Probation & The Trumpets)"

If 2022 is the last Sabbatical year before the 6000 years end on the *Day of Atonement* in 2023, then, as I explained on pages 16-18 of my study, the persecution, or the scattering of "the power of the holy people" (Daniel 12:7-10), will commence during the Feast of Unleavened Bread in 2023!

It is my hope that if you have not taken the time to study that document, this 4-page summary will inspire you to do so. The 18-page study can be found in my website www.SundayLawAlert.com under the Tab "Studies," in English and Spanish.

As prophesied TWICE in Daniel 12 verses 4 & 9, as we get closer to the end, God is revealing things that we have "seen" but "never understood" before. Not because they are "new light," but because as it happened in 1844, to separate the "wise" from the "foolish" virgins, "His hand was over and hid a mistake in some of the figures, so that none could see it, until His hand was removed." "-Early Writings, 74

On October 22, 1844, in fulfillment of Leviticus 16:15-17 and Daniel 8:14, Jesus entered the most holy place to "commence" the cleansing of the heavenly sanctuary. In Leviticus 16:18, Jesus leaves the most holy place, "never to return," to complete the "final cleansing" from the holy place. "And he shall go out unto the altar that is before the Lord, and make an atonement for it." -Leviticus 16:18.

There is no altar in the "most holy place." The "altar that is before the LORD" -Leviticus 16:12 is also known as the "altar of incense" -Exodus 30:27 and "the golden altar ... before the vail." -Exodus 40:26 and it is found in the holy place! <u>It is from this golden altar</u>, -Revelation 8:3 <u>in the holy place</u>, that the censer is "cast into the earth" by Jesus, and probation closes.

When Jesus leaves the most holy place in Leviticus 16:18, the "cleansing of the sanctuary" is not completed. There are still 16 more verses in Leviticus 16 before the "final cleansing" takes place NOW, 179 years later!

It is imperative that we understand that according to Leviticus 16, there are 2 events that "must" take place on 2 different Days of Atonement, each separated by one year, before the Second Coming of Christ:

1) The exit of the high priest from the most holy place, -Lev. 16:18 and 2) The 1000-year banishment of Satan to the desolate earth. -Lev. 16:22 Since the Day of Atonement only happens once a year, and each of these Days

of Atonement have other events associated with it, it follows that they must be separated by at least one year!

Jesus, our high priest, must fulfill "every verse" of Leviticus 16. The chapter has 34 verses, and He leaves the most holy place, never to return, in Leviticus 16:18. Every activity that Jesus performs from Leviticus 16:18 until the end of the chapter, and every activity from Revelation 4:1, until the end of the book, takes place in the holy place, not in the most holy! This is new to us, but it is as old as Leviticus 16 and irrefutable from Scripture or the Spirit of Prophecy, furthermore, it is clearly explained in *Early Writings* and *The Great Controversy*.

In the year 2015, the Ellen G. White Estate released for the first time the ONLY commentary from Mrs. White on Daniel 12:7-10. Daniel asked the angel: "How long shall it be to the end of these wonders?" —Daniel 12:6 The angel replied: "It shall be for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these things shall be finished." —Daniel 12:7 Daniel was confused and asked the same question a second time. Do you think this is important?

"And I heard, but I understood not: then said I, O my Lord, <u>what shall be the end of these things?</u> And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and <u>sealed till the time of the end.</u> Many shall be <u>purified, and made white, and tried;</u> but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand." —Daniel 12:8-10.

After persecution ends, Satan can no longer scatter the power of the holy people. The same period of "time, times, and an half" in Daniel 12:7 is used 7 times in Scripture as "<u>forty and two months</u>," "1260 days," and "time, times, and an half." (Dan. 7:25; 12:7; Rev. 11:2; 11:3; 12:6; 12:14; and 13:5.) Of the 7 times, Mrs. White applied 5, using "prophetic time" to the period of papal persecution from A.D. 538 to 1798. Revelation 12:14 has never been applied, and Daniel 12:7 has only been applied once.

3 points for you to consider:

- 1. Revelation 12:14 has never been applied, therefore the fulfillment of this prophecy is still pending and must be in "literal" not "prophetic" days
- 2. Revelation 13:5 The papal wound was inflicted in 1798 (Rev. 13:3), it began healing in 1929 when Mussolini gave the Vatican back to the pope (Rev. 13:3), since then the world has "wondered after the beast" (Rev. 13:3), THEN, in verse 5, "power was given unto him to continue forty and two months" (Rev. 13:5.) These 42 months MUST have a "final fulfillment" at the end of time in "literal" not "prophetic" days.
- 3. <u>Daniel 12:7-10</u> Here's the statement released in 2015; you decide if the "final fulfillment" of this prophecy can be applied in "prophetic time" (one day

for each year), as it was applied in the five of the seven usages previously mentioned.

"Daniel writes . . . 'that it shall be for a time, times, and an half, and when he shall have accomplished, to scatter the power of the holy people, all these things shall be finished' [Dan. 12:7-10 quoted.] The world is a theatre. The actors, the inhabitants of the world, are preparing to act their part in the last great drama. God is lost sight of ... A power from beneath is working to bring about the last great scenes in the drama—Satan coming as Christ. ... Transgression has almost reached its limit. Confusion fills the world, and a great terror is soon to come upon human beings. The end is very near. We who know the truth should be preparing for what is soon to break upon the world as an overwhelming surprise." —Ellen G. White, Letter 141, 1902

Strong's Concordance assigns its #4150 MOED to the words: "time" and "times" in Daniel 12:7, and defines it thus: "an appointment, i.e., a fixed time or season; spec. a festival." As a result, the persecution or scattering of God's people in Daniel 12:7 should be counted in MOEDs and not literal days.

On page 18 of my study, I stated: Until the "unrolling of the scroll," we cannot be sure if MOED applies to one of God's feasts, or to the 7 "holy convocations," that take place during God's feasts.

- 1. Counting back in "feasts" from the Day of Atonement in 2023 takes us to the "midst" or "half" of the Feast of Tabernacles in 2022.
- Counting back in "holy convocations" from the Day of Atonement in 2023 takes us to the "midst" or "half" of the Feast of Unleavened Bread in 2023.

Since "persecution" or <u>"to scatter the power of the holy people,"</u> did not commence in Tabernacles 2022, then it follows that it must start during the feast of Unleavened Bread in 2023.

Now, let's look again at the 42 months of Revelation 13:5. There are two points to consider. Point #1 is that we are not sure when this 42-month period starts, but we are sure when it ends. We have seen how "the Saviour's prophecy concerning the visitation of judgments upon Jerusalem is to have <u>another fulfillment</u>, of which that terrible desolation was but a faint shadow." —The Great Controversy, 36 We have been warned to "study Revelation in connection with Daniel, <u>for history will be repeated.</u>" —Testimonies to Ministers and Gospel Workers, 116 We have also been warned as follows:

"In the last days Satan will appear as an angel of light, with great power and heavenly glory, and claim to be the Lord of the whole earth. He will <u>declare</u> that the Sabbath has been changed from the seventh to the first day of the week; and as lord of the first day of the week he will <u>present</u> this spurious sabbath as a test of loyalty to him. <u>THEN will take place the FINAL fulfillment</u> of the Revelator's prophecy. 'And they worshiped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshiped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who

is able to make war with him? And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies and power was given unto him to *continue* forty and two months.' [Revelation 13:4-18 quoted]" —*Manuscript Releases*, Vol. 19, p. 282

The 42-month period takes place in verse 5, AFTER the wound was healed in 1929 in verse 3, and therefore it must have a future application of 42-months or 1260 days in literal time! The pen of inspiration reveals that persecution ends when we are "delivered" by the voice of God.

"As the third message swells to a loud cry, and as great power and glory attend the closing work, the faithful people of God will partake of that glory. ... The decree will go forth that they must disregard the Sabbath of the fourth commandment, and honor the first day, or lose their lives ... Satan's host, and wicked men, will surround them. ... The sea boils like a pot, and the whole earth is in terrible commotion. The captivity of the righteous is turned, and with sweet and solemn whisperings they say to one another: "We are delivered. It is the voice of God" ... Satan and evil angels flee from the presence of the saints glorified. Their power to annoy them is gone forever."

—Testimonies for the Church, Vol. 1, pp. 353, 354

"It was at midnight that God chose to deliver His people ... The streams ceased to flow. Dark, heavy clouds came up and clashed against each other. But there was one clear place of settled glory, whence came the voice of God like many waters, shaking the heavens and the earth. ... The sea boiled like a pot and cast out stones upon the land. And as God spoke the day and the hour of Jesus' coming ... At the end of every sentence the saints shouted, 'Glory! Hallelujah!' Their countenances were lighted up with the glory of God, and they shone with glory as did the face of Moses when he came down from Sinai. ... Then commenced the jubilee, when the land should rest. ... Soon appeared the great white cloud, upon which sat the Son of man." -Early Writings, 285, 286 The commencement of the Jubilee herein mentioned is the grand jubilee of jubilees where the land rests for 1,000 years. This event takes place at the end of the 6000 years on the Day of Atonement in 2023!

"As the <u>time appointed</u> in the decree draws near, the people will conspire to root out the hated sect. ... <u>It is now, in the hour of utmost extremity</u>, that the God of Israel will interpose for the <u>deliverance</u> of His chosen. Saith the Lord: 'Ye shall have a song, as in the night when a <u>holy solemnity</u> is kept; and gladness of heart, as when one goeth ... to come into the mountain of Jehovah, to the Mighty One of Israel. <u>And the Lord shall cause His glorious voice to be heard</u>, and shall show the lighting down of His arm, with the indignation of His anger, and with the flame of a devouring fire, with scattering, and tempest, and hailstones.' <u>Isaiah 30:29, 30.</u>" -The Great Controversy, 635, 636

Did you notice the words "holy solemnity" above? We will revisit them in a moment. Did you also notice the words "time appointed?" They are used once in Daniel 8:19, three times in Daniel 11:27, 29, 35, and once in Habakkuk 2:3. Strong's

Concordance assigns its #4150 MOED to the word "appointed" in all 5 usages and defines it thus: "an appointment, i.e. <u>a fixed time or season; spec. a festival.</u>" "For the vision is yet for an <u>appointed time</u>, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry." -Habakkuk 2:3

What did the Holy Spirit mean by the "time appointed" in her commentary on Isaiah 30:29, 30? In the last book written by Mrs. White, the Holy Spirit confirmed that it applies to the Day of Atonement, "And at the <u>time appointed</u>—on the <u>tenth day of the seventh month</u>—the <u>solemn services</u> of the <u>Day of Atonement</u> were performed according to the command of God."

<u>Prophets and Kings</u>, 665

Let's look again at the words, "<u>holy solemnity</u>" on page 635 of *The Great Controversy* above. They appear only twice in the King James Version. One of those is the usage in Isaiah 30:29 quoted in page 635. Notice the other! "And Moses commanded them, saying, <u>At the end of every seven years</u>, in the <u>solemnity</u> of the <u>year of release</u>, in the feast of Tabernacles." —Deuteronomy 31:10 Strong's Concordance assigns its #2282 to the word "solemnity" and defines it thus: "<u>a festival . . . (solemn) feast day.</u>"

The Jewish Economy revolves around the Jubilee Year, which is the climax of 7 Sabbatical cycles, each one ending on a Sabbatical year. The Sabbatical year is also known as the "acceptable year of the Lord," "Isaiah 61:2; Luke 4:19" "The year of release," "Deuteronomy 31:10" "The year of my redeemed," "Isaiah 63:4" and "The year of recompenses." "Isaiah 34:8" It is a Biblical principle that God's people will be delivered "at the end" of a Sabbatical year.

"At the end of every seven years thou shalt make a release."

—Deuteronomy 15:1 "At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release."—Deuteronomy 31:10 At the end of seven years let ye go every man his brother."—Jeremiah 34:14.

The Sabbatical year always takes place <u>"at the end"</u> of every seven years. The Sabbatical year always commences and ends on the Day of Atonement. -Leviticus 25:9

No serious Bible student can argue that the Day of Atonement in 2022 is NOT "the end" of a Sabbatical Year. The ministry of Jesus lasted 3-1/2 years. His ministry commenced in A.D. 27, and He was crucified 3-1/2 years later, in the "midst of the week," of the Sabbatical year that ended in A.D. 34, in fulfillment of Daniel 9:24-27. "And he shall confirm the covenant with many for <u>one week:</u> and in the <u>midst of the week</u> he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease." —Daniel 9:27

"Then, said the angel, 'He shall confirm the covenant with many for <u>one week [seven years].</u>' For seven years after the Saviour entered on His ministry, the gospel was to be preached especially to the Jews; for <u>three and a half years by Christ Himself</u>; and afterward by the apostles. '<u>In the midst of the week</u>

He shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease." Daniel 9:27. In the spring of A. D. 31, Christ the true sacrifice was offered on Calvary. ... The <u>one week—seven years—ended in A. D. 34." -The Desire of Ages, 233. [Emphasis in brackets and hyphens was added by Mrs. White]</u>

Please take your calculator and punch in 27 (when Jesus commenced His ministry.) If you subtract by 7 (Sabbatical cycles) or 49 (Jubilee cycles) you will end up in 457 B.C., the commencement of the 2300-day prophecy (remember the year zero does not count.) If you add by 7, you will end up on the Day of Atonement on October 6, 2022.

The eight most important Biblical events (457 B.C., A.D. 27, A.D. 31, A.D. 34, A.D. 538, A.D. 1798, A.D. 1840, and A.D. 1844) all took place on Sabbatical or "Midst of Week" years, and all are found in *The Great Controversy*. If we move ANY one year, they all fall apart. *This Is Too Perfect To Be Just Coincidence!*

As explained in my 18-page study, **IF** in fact Jesus left the most holy place at the end of the Sabbatical year, in the solemnity of "the year of release," on the Day of Atonement in 2022, pursuant to Leviticus 16:18 and Revelation 4:1, **THEN**, before He did so, every case was decided when the marriage was consummated in the "most holy place," and "there was given him dominion, and glory, and a *kingdom*." -Daniel 7:14.

"Then I saw that Jesus would not leave the most holy place until <u>every case was decided.</u> ... Therefore what is done to rescue souls from the coming storm of wrath <u>must be done before Jesus leaves the most holy place</u> of the heavenly sanctuary." —Early Writings, 36, 48 Jesus knows which ones of us will be faithful unto the end. The angels, the rest of the universe and Satan do not. Every case is decided in secret, to weed out the foolish virgins, which as it happened in 1844, went back to "business as usual" after the great disappointment.

During the year that follows His exit from the "most holy place," until we are delivered by the voice of God on the Day of Atonement, the "seals," the "trumpets," and the plagues "will be the means used to weed out all those that will not form part of God's kingdom, which Jesus received "before" He left the most holy place.

So, what is the purpose of the Trumpets and the Plagues? Is the purpose of *Jacob's Time of Trouble*, the *Trumpets*, and the *Plagues* to punish the wicked? NO. Except for the Exodus from Egypt, all the wicked from the time of Adam never endured anything like the plagues. Most of the people before this last generation had 60-70 years to perfect their character. *Now*, it is necessary to give a 25-yr old, seeing this message for the first time, a Sunday Law test, and if he is faithful "unto death," he will be safe to take to heaven. The risk for the universe is just too great.

"The whole universe will have become witnesses to the nature and results of sin. And its utter extermination, which in the beginning would have brought fear to angels and dishonor to God, will now vindicate His love and establish His honor before the universe of beings who delight to do His will, and in whose heart is His law. Never will evil again be manifest. Says the word of God: 'Affliction shall not rise up the second time.' Nahum 1:9. The law of God, which Satan has reproached as the yoke of bondage, will be honored as the law of liberty. A tested and proved creation will never again be turned from allegiance to Him whose character has been fully manifested before them as fathomless love and infinite wisdom." -The Great Contenters 504

Point #2 regarding the 42-month period deals with the word "continue," in Revelation 13:5. In my Leviticus 16 series, I had this 42-month period ending at the end of the Sabbatical year on the Day of Atonement in 2022 and this was my mistake. As I explained in my 18-page study, in slide 709 in Part 5 of my YouTube Series entitled: "6000 Years End In The Year 2022," and published 5 years earlier, it is shown that 2022 is not the end of the 6000 Years but the last Sabbatical year before the 6000 years end on the Day of Atonement in 2023. Now let's look at Revelation 13:5 one more time.

The ministry of Jesus lasted 42 months. It is my assumption, that for the benefit of the universe looking on for nearly 6,000 years, Satan, at the end of his time, has also been granted a period of 42 months or 1260 days. A careful reading of Satan's personification of Christ in *Manuscript Releases*, Volume 19, page 282 cited above, does not suggest that the 42 months start after the personification of Christ. The key word here is "continue," in Revelation 13:5.

Never in the history of humanity, has Satan had the power that he has exercised over the last 3 years, to "shut down" all of the world economies, to "shut down" and create division in the churches, the workplace, and the home over the vaccine mandate. Thousands of businesses around the world have disappeared. Millions are suffering from mental disorders and depression or have died from causes now being traced to the vaccine.

Now. when America and the world are at their weakest point and experiencing financial ruin, war, poverty, inflation, crime, lack of food, and natural disasters of unprecedented frequency and magnitude, Satan will personify Christ and "<u>suggest</u>" that the only solution is to worship God on Sunday, thus giving the earth time to rest and making the connection to Climate Change, pursuant to the pope's agenda in *Laudato Si*'.

The first known case of COVID-19 was identified in Wuhan, China in December 2019. In my opinion, sometime after said date, this 42-month period of Revelation 13:5 commenced. and will *continue* until the voice of God delivers His people from persecution, on the Day of Atonement in 2023!

Those of us that are praying to be part of the "wise virgins" know not where our Lord may send us when this crisis breaks. Lest we arrive at a place of refuge and be a burden to others, it would be good for us to own certain items for each member of our family. Friends, the world needs *The Great Controversy*, but we need *The Desire of Ages* to have the character of Jesus. Now that I have understood Leviticus 16 and the activities of Jesus in the heavenly Sanctuary as never before, I am reading this book again, and it's been a real eye opener. We have been admonished: "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?" -2 Corinthians 13:5

I challenge you to read Chapter 31 in *The Desire of Ages* (The Sermon on the Mount,) and examine yourself. We are not prepared for the coming storm, but if we understand the principles in this chapter, we will be prepared for the spiritual wickedness that is headed our way!

The "strong delusion" prophesied by Paul in 2 Thessalonians 2:11, 12 is about to be fulfilled and "none but those who have fortified the mind with the truths of the Bible will stand through the last great conflict." -*The Great Controversy*, 593.

In closing I would urge you to commit to memory and obey the conditional promises in John 8:31, 32 and John 15:7. By the grace of God, this is our ticket to heaven. Be strong; Jesus comes soon!
