2025 Irrigation Season

Irrigation season is near! Starting on May 1, you will have an increased water allowance and we will move to Stage 1 Conservation to allow for lawn and garden irrigation.

Right now, we are on **Stage 3 Conservation**. This means that outdoor irrigation is not permitted and limited only for hand-watering trees and ornamental plants. Stay tuned for updates to this stage based on weather and drought conditions. Please follow the guidelines below to conserve outdoor water use and save money:

- Irrigate between May 1 and October 31
- Water lawns no more than three days per week
- Lawn irrigation shall occur between 6:00 pm and 9:00 am
- Monitor sprinkler heads to make sure they are not spraying beyond the irrigation zone onto concrete
- You may be overwatering if you see water pooling at your curb and flowing down the street
- If you are installing a new lawn, you may obtain a New Lawn Irrigation Permit from the Cottonwood Water & Sanitation District to allow for revisions to your water allocation during a period of 30 days after your new lawn has been installed. Please call our office for further details.
- Avoid watering while it is raining or during high winds.
- Repair a leaky sprinkler system or broken sprinkler head as soon as it is detected
