- Compare usage over time
- Make informed decisions about irrigation and indoor water use

Whether you're home or away, this tool helps you stay in control and avoid surprises on your water bill.

Setting up EyeOnWater is simple. Just visit eyeonwater.com and follow the prompts using your water account number. You can also download the app on your smartphone for easy access any-time by scanning the QR code:
