Water Meter Upgrades

The District has received the remaining supply to continue to upgrade water meters throughout our service area. District staff needs to schedule an appointment for our operators to access the meter in the basement or crawl space of your home. You may receive an email or phone call if the District has one on file — you can always reach out to us to schedule your meter upgrade by calling the District at 303-792-9509. Once you have a smart meter installed /upgraded, you will then have access to the new app, EyeOnWater, that will help you track your water use (updated every 15 minutes!) and possible leaks, a great feature during this cold weather season and even when you are away from home.

Winter is Upon Us

Prepare for the bitter cold temperatures of the season. Here is some advice for how to help prevent water pipes from freezing.

The pipes within your home that are most susceptible are those in crawl spaces and next to exterior walls. Provide ambient heat to these areas by opening cabinet or crawl space doors. Or place a safe heat source near the pipes. If leaving your home, don't set your thermostat below 65 degrees.

If your water pipes are frozen, or there is only a trickle coming out of your fixtures, you can apply heat with a blow dryer or similar heat source to get heat to disperse through your plumbing system. Pipes warmed too fast can also burst, so please do not use a blow torch or other intense heat source.

If your pipe does burst, turn off your water at your main shut-off valve. The main shut off is located on the waterline connected to your water meter. It is recommended to call a plumber at this point.

Winter Watering

Even in years when drought is not a concern – winter watering of trees is important, especially with evergreen trees. That's because tree roots, unlike dormant grasses, will continue to grow throughout the winter. Thus, they need moisture to survive. This time of year, shoveling snow can be more than just safety. Piling snow that is shoveled from driveways and sidewalks into the yard instead of the street allows the snow to melt slowly into the soil. It

is also great for some extra winter watering. Piling snow into the street can create ice dams, making hazards for vehicles and preventing snow melt from reaching the stormdrain. Snow plows are about access for safety, not necessarily eliminating snow.
