

Go paperless with E-Statements!

For the past few months, the Cottonwood Water District has been sending e-statements along with a paper billing statement mailed to your home. We are encouraging customers to join us in saving paper by electing to only receive an E-statement. If you only need an emailed monthly statement and do not need a paper statement mailed to your home, please notify us by email (info@cottonwoodwater.org) or phone (303-792-9509).

The District also offers customers another opportunity to save paper and postage by signing up for automatic monthly ACH bill payments. Visit our website at https://www.cottonwoodwater.org/ach-form/. Signing up is easy, just fill in the form, upload a copy of a voided check and hit 'send'. Your secure email will be processed for the next bank withdrawal. If you elect automatic payments, your statement will indicate the amount that will be withdrawn and the District will draft your bank account on the 25th of each month. You never have late payment charges from forgetting to make your payment or issues with payments lost in the mail.

Water Conservation Workshop

Colorado is a dry climate with limited water supplies. Cottonwood Water encourages water conservation through rebates on water conserving appliances (<u>https://www.cottonwoodwater.org/rebates</u>), participation in the Garden in a Box program, tiered water rates, and recommended 3 day a week watering programs.

To provide additional information on water conservation, the District is scheduling a workshop for Saturday, July 20th at 10:00am at the District meeting house located at 8334 Sandreed Circle. This workshop will provide information on water conservation. The workshop is free, however, we need participants to make reservations for the event. For years, Cottonwood Water has partnered with the Tri-County Health Department serving Adams, Arapahoe and Douglas Counties, in sponsoring the Household Chemical Roundups. These Roundups help dispose of chemical waste properly, prevent pollution and protect the people handling our garbage. When household chemicals are not used up, they must be disposed of properly or it can harm to sanitation workers, create problems in sewage treatment plants and landfills or affect water and air quality.
