Cottonwood Community Garden


Come explore the Cottonwood Community Garden at 8334 Sandreed Circle!

Water Allocation Cheatsheet...

Below is a friendly reminder as to how your water allocation is calculated for each month throughout the year. The Board is currently vetting options to improve how your water bill reads as effort to give you all the tools you need to manage your water.

January	Winter Avg. 1 + 1,500	 2	Indoor
