OUTDOOR WATERING NOTICE

At the April 16 public Board meeting, the Cottonwood Water and Sanitation District Board of Directors voted to advance the outdoor water conservation efforts from **Stage 1 to Stage 2**. The only changes at this time are the number of days per week and hours during which you may water your lawn. The District will continue monitoring local water supplies throughout the summer and will keep you informed if further changes are needed. Visit the District's website for details on all four outdoor watering conservation stages.

Cottonwood Water Trash Collection Program

Nearly 50% of the homes that qualify for the Program have signed up and are on the road to save hundreds of dollars! The option is yours to join the program. For **approximately \$16.13/month**, participants receive:

- ◆ Weekly trash and biweekly recycling collection every Thursday (holiday delays apply)
- ◆ Two 96-gallon totes (one trash and one recycling)
- ◆ One combined monthly bill from the District
- ◆ Safer, quieter streets with fewer trucks and less roadside clutter **and much more!**

Try us out! If you are not satisfied, you can opt out of the program between November 2 and November 16.
