Board to Discuss Outdoor Water Restrictions if Drought Conditions Occur

The Cottonwood Water and Sanitation District Board of Directors is keeping a close eye on drought conditions in Colorado. Should the need arise, we will move to Conservation Stage 2. In order to conserve water now to avoid restrictions later, consider using the following guidelines:

- Water only during the hours of 6pm-9am. Overnight watering allows the water to soak into the ground and give your plants and lawn a chance to use the water before it evaporates.
- Turn off your sprinklers during or after a heavy storm. Let nature do the work!
- Limit your watering to three days a week to give your lawn a chance to develop deeper roots.
- Sign up for a sprinkler audit with Resource Central to learn how to efficiently set up your system. Register at ResourceCentral.org/Sprinklers or call (303) 999-3824.
