Residential Indoor Allocations: Sewer Average & Water Budget

Your Cottonwood Water & Sanitation bill includes two items: "Sewer Average" and "Budget." These are based on your water usage from December to March and are used to calculate your monthly sewer average as well as the indoor water budget, which includes an extra 1,500 gallons. These figures are then applied year-round, starting with the April bill of every year. Outdoor water allocations are calculated separately and added to your indoor water budget from May through October. For details, please visit our website or simply give us call and we'll be happy to assist you with any questions!

We encourage you to monitor and manage your water usage with EyeOnWater. This is a free service full of amazing tools, including leak detection. No financial information is required to use the application, and it is accessible via a smart device or web browser.


