Board Meetings

- Occur monthly
- For board members to make strategic decisions, vote on resolutions, contracts, and policies.
- Discuss handling of day-to-day operations, finances, and funding opportunities.
- Enforce rules/address issues.
- Discuss the status of committees or other projects.
- All members are welcome to observe and voice opinions, but within the context of an agenda set by the board.



General Meetings

- Occur at most quarterly
- A platform for all members of the community to be informed and provide input.
- Board will provide a summary of the status of current projects.
- Agenda items based primarily on member interests and requests; members may submit and vote on agenda items prior to the meeting.
- Members will vote on officers, election of board members, or changes to by-laws.
