The Court of Appeals, the highest court in New York State, is still "deliberating" whether the city can move all city retirees into a Medicare Advantage Plan without their consent. The Courts decision should be released within the next few months and this issue should then be settled. We should not be placing all our eggs in one basket (no pun intended) without a Plan "B," to protect our hard-earned medical benefits. We need to continue the pressure on the City Council to implement Intro Bill 1096 to ensure our medical benefits. Do all you can to get this bill passed.

Membership Meeting of March 12, 2025

Pastor Jack Martin, Chaplin for the New York Fire Department Retirees, provides the benediction at the March meeting of the Hernando 10-13.







Pastor Jack Martin also spoke to the members about the events relating to the protests in Washington DC on January 6, 2021. Pastor Martin specifically spoke about "Jeremy Brown" one of the demonstrators in Washington DC that day.

Jeremy Brown served in the Army from 1992 to 2012 serving as a Special Forces communications sergeant. He had multiple deployments, including Colombia in 2004, Afghanistan in 2005 and 2011, and Iraq in 2007 and 2009. He retired as a master sergeant, according to Army records. He served with the 1st, 7th, and 5th Special Forces Groups.

Jemery Brown was linked to an explosives-laden RV that was allegedly brought to the Washington area around Jan. 6, 2021 according to DOJ prosecutors, and was sentenced to seven years in prison after federal agents discovered some 8,000 rounds of ammunition in his possession, along with two explosive grenades, an unregistered rifle modified to have a short barrel, and an unregistered sawed-off shotgun, and retention of classified information. In addition, when police raided his home, they also discovered multiple stacks of cash and military manuals, including one for training snipers

Jemery alleges that the government search warrant was illegal and evidence used to convict him had been planted by the government. He is appealing these issues.

<u>Jan. 6</u> defendants who got hit with <u>additional charges</u> that weren't directly related to the U.S. Capitol attack — like <u>owning illegal weapons</u> or <u>fleeing justice</u> — still appear to be facing the music for those separate crimes. In addition to granting pardons to the vast majority of convicted Jan. 6 rioters and commutations of sentence to a handful of others, President Donald Trump also ordered the DOJ to "pursue dismissal with prejudice to the government of all pending indictments" against accused defendants.
