

I just received the information on the scholarship fund and the application. An application and instructions were sent to all members by email. The Scholarship Program is open to any and all family members of NYPD Retirees who are members in good standing of any 10-13 club associated with the New York 10-13 Associations of America, Inc., including their adopted children. All applicants must be entering their first year of college. Applications must be completely filled out to the best of ability, sponsored and notarized. All applications must be submitted and received or postmarked on or before July 15th of the current year

Below is a list of demands from the city to the Municipal Labor Committee regarding Health Benefits negotiations.

THE CITY OF NEW YORK PROPOSALS TO THE MLC HEALTH BENEFITS BARGAINING


- 1. Implement co-premiums on all basic plans to reflect industry practice
- Establish co-payments and deductibles in the HIP-HMO plan to approximate the design of the GHI / Blue Cross CBP plan.
- 3. Elimination of the Medicare Part B reimbursement for all covered dependents.
- Elimination of the Medicare Part B reimbursement for the income adjusted additions to Medicare premiums.
- Eliminate the City's \$35M annual contribution to the Health Insurance Stabilization Fund.
- Eliminate the annual \$65 welfare fund contribution funded by the Health Insurance Stabilization Fund.
- 7. Reduce the City's contribution to welfare funds.
- Implement Medicare plans that generate savings to the program, e.g., Medicare Advantage plans. Establish new benchmark as described in #10.
- Establish co-payments and deductibles in the HIP-VIP plan to approximate the design of the GHI / Blue Cross CBP plan. (Copays on certain services currently in place).
- Eliminate GHI Senior Care premiums as benchmark for Medicare plans. Replace with a set rate which can be indexed each year based on Medical CPI or a Medicare Advantage plan.
- Eliminate HIP HMO as the benchmark. Replace with a set rate which can be indexed each year based on Medical CPI.
- (12) Fund a review of recertification of dependents.
- (3) Allow only a family contract where two city employees/retirees are enrolled in separate plans and there is at least one dependent child on the coverage.
- (14) Jointly support an amendment of the Administrative Code such that retiree eligibility for health benefits for vested and service retirement shall be at least 15 years of credited pension service.

The City reserves the right to add or amend proposals.

If you lost your ID Card or it was stolen the form must be accompanied by a Police Report from your local Police Department or Sheriff's office.
