PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

August 2025

Last month the Hernando 10-13 Club sent an e-mail relating to how the Medicare Advantage switch cheats NYC retirees. Four years ago, July 14, 2021, then-Mayor Bill de Blasio announced he was going to make retirees pay for Medicare supplemental insurance coverage that the city had funded for nearly half a century. The NYC Retirees Organization, a coalition of former firefighters, police officers, teachers, lawyers, and other retired NYC workers objected to this unilateral change. Litigation ensued and a substantial amount of time, effort and money was expended to protect NYC workers health coverage rights. This effort has taken some time to work its way through the courts and now the highest court in New York State (Court of Appeals) has rendered a decision that the city did not have to keep its word when it promised to provide health insurance coverage to its employees upon retirement. As luck would have it, Mayor Adams who is currently looking to get reelected as mayor of New York City announced he would not be forcing retirees into a Medicare Advantage plan. After the devastating court decision, the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees (<https://www.nycretirees.org/>) believes now is time for the City Council to step up. It needs to codify retirees' right to traditional Medicare plus supplemental insurance. There is a bill pending — Intro 1096 sponsored by Councilmember Chris Marte — that would protect retirees. But Speaker Adrienne Adams has refused to allow it to come to the floor for a vote. Please go to the retirees' web site where you will find information on providing support whether it is a donation of money or making phone calls.

Thank you for your support. I look forward to seeing you at the next Hernando 10-13 Club meeting, scheduled for September 3rd, 2025.

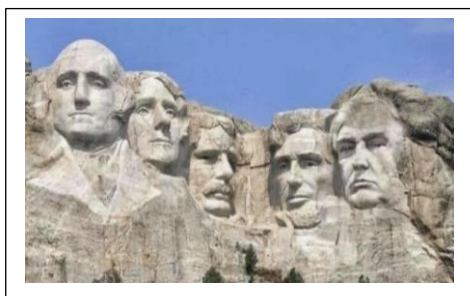

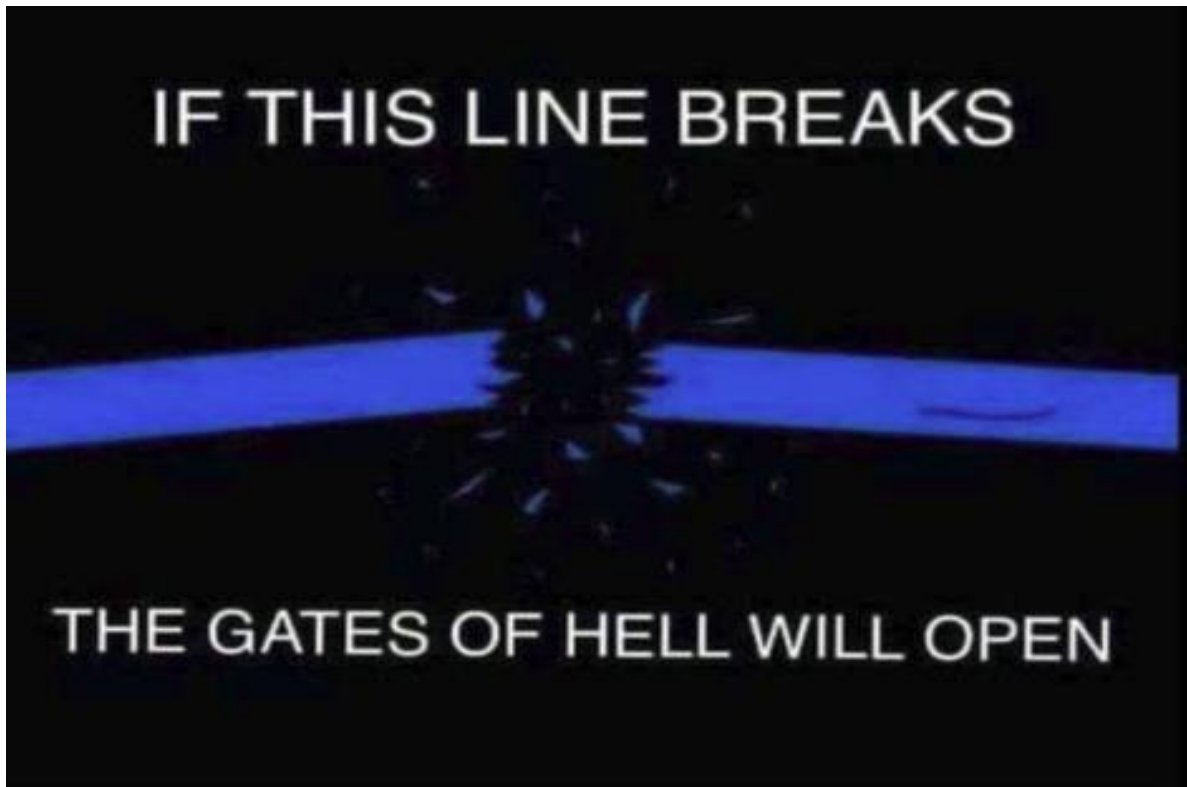

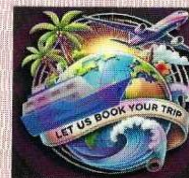
