During the November 12th meeting we had the pleasure of listening to Mr. Donald DiMonda of Springhill, FL explain the purpose of his organization, the Nature Coast chapter of the "100 Men Who Care" Alliance. Each chapter is a group of up to 100 men, is tasked with providing local charitable entities (501c3) the ability to obtain donations through quarterly presentations and needs assessments.

Once a quarter, the members gather at a local establishment and each member commits to donate \$100 to provide meaningful support to deserving charities and non-profit organizations operating in Hernando County and surrounding areas. (Total Annual commitment is \$400). Events are conducted in 90 minutes or less. Each event will include an update on how the funds donated at the previous meeting were used by the recipient charity. Any member may nominate a charity for consideration but must be done 2 weeks prior to the upcoming meeting either online or by emailing downloadable form in order to confirm eligibility. Three charities/non-profits will be chosen at random and be given 5-7 minutes to share with members about their organization and what they do for the local community. Each member may vote (by ballot) for one of the three charities. The charity with the most votes will be the recipient charity. Each member will write a check for \$100 to the recipient charity.

We are hooking up with the Suncoast 10-13 for the annual "Day at the Races" at Tampa Bay Downs. The date is set


