

Instruction for Transit PD ID card renewals can be found on the club web site <u>www.hernando10-13.com</u>.



Your club president will send the application directly to the messenger. Individuals CANNOT mail this form to the messenger directly. He will accept ID CARD RENEWALS from Club Presidents ONLY.


If you lost your ID Card or it was stolen the form must be accompanied by a Police Report from your local Police Department or Sheriff's office.

NOTICE TO MEMBERS

AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF HERNANDO COUNTY 10-13 CLUB SUBMITTED BY MEMBER ARTHUR BABCOCK TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS ON JANUARY 18, 2024

The Board of Directors by majority vote on January 18, 2024, presents to the general membership for adoption, at the upcoming meeting of February 14, 2024, the following amendments to the Hernando County 10-13 Constitution and By Laws, promulgated on September 14, 1993 and as previously amended on January 9, 2002; January 14, 2004; May 11, 2005 & August 7,2007 (hereinafter "By-Laws").

The By-Laws are amended as follows:

ARTICLE IV DUES

Section 1 Is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following *"Section 1."*

The annual dues shall be as follows:

- (a) \$40.00 per member. \$5.00 initiation fee upon joining
- (b) \$20.00 per Lifetime Member
- (c) Honorary Members shall not be required to pay dues.

Said amounts may be changed upon the recommendation of the Board of Directors and presented to the membership for approval at a regularly scheduled meeting.

ARTICLE VII OUORUM

"Section 3. Is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following *"Section 3.*

The presence of 15 members at a Regular meeting or Special meeting shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting Club business that requires a general vote of the membership.
