PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

February 2023

As we move into this new year we find not much has changed from last year. The mayor is continuing in his attempt to renege on the city's obligations previously made through negotiations to provide quality health care insurance to retirees. First the city announces that retirees, in a cost saving measure, will have an option to move to a Medicare Advantage Plan or have the pleasure of paying a monthly fee plus co-pays for the same health insurance coverage currently provide at no cost. Fortunately, the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees took the lead in suing the city and obtaining a verdict preventing the city from imposing their vision of premier health insurance coverage. Several efforts have been turned back by the courts yet the city, and their labor union cohorts, are now attempting to change the Administrative Code Section 12-126 to remove any obligation of the city to absorb the cost of retirees health insurance coverage. The unions representing the Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants, and Detectives have been vocal with their objection to the city's effort. The PBA has been silent on this issue and could not even find time to provide an up or down vote on the city's attempt to modify the Administration Code Section 12-126. We should consider supporting those who are aiding in maintaining our health insurance benefits.

As we receive information regarding this very important issue to us all, we will pass it along. Along these lines Joe Wolff and Ed Dunbar have been working on developing a Web Page for Hernando 10-13 Club which will contain all this information in addition to other items of interest. The Web site is not totally complete however, it is far enough along to make it public. 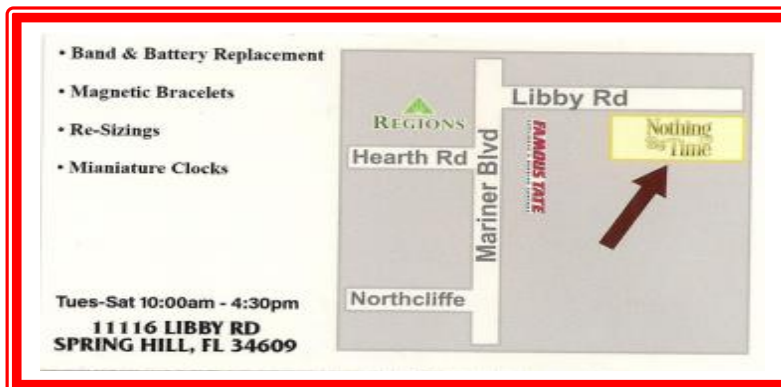

If your retired ID card is going to expire, has expired or has been lost & wish to renew your ID Card via the mail, please fill out the attached form & give it to Your club President by February 24th.

They will be sent to the messenger directly as he will be going to 1PP in March.

If you lost your ID Card or it was stolen the form must be accompanied by a Police Report from your local Police Department or Sheriff's office.

The NYPD is driving into the future with new patrol cars.

NYPD Commissioner Keechant Sewell announced the change to the “iconic” vehicles Wednesday during an annual New York City Police Foundation breakfast. She said even icons need occasional updates.

“With a new look outside and a more comfortable feel inside — this potential new design for our fleet encompasses input from our members while representing the traditions of the police department,” Sewell said.

The new vehicles will feature a design on the side similar to the design of the NYPD flag. There will be green stripes and white stars.

Outside of the appearance difference, there will also be a 360-degree camera system to increase safety, Sewell said. There will also be a QR code on the sides of vehicles for community members to scan.

The NYPD currently has 11,220 vehicles. Sewell has not said how many vehicles would be replaced or how much it would cost.
